## **Review process**

**BCC Policy Requirement** 

• Review of certain BCCs every two years.

#### Criteria

• Eight met policy criteria and were engaged by the City Clerk's Office

### State of Local Emergency Context

• Worked closely with BCCs and considered workload impacts of COVID-19



# What Was Reviewed?

Mandate

• The work and scope of the body: relevance and alignment with Council expectations.

## Composition

- Considered:
  - Membership criteria is still appropriate? (Specialized or general representation).
  - Member types (Council, Administration and public members).
  - How members are recruited/appointed (recruitment campaign, nominations).

### Resourcing

 Providing the level of advisory, support, training and governance resources required to achieve success in the mandate.



## **Summary of Review Outcomes**

#### No Review Performed

- Calgary Aboriginal Urban Affairs Committee, Calgary General Hospital Legacy Fund Review Committee –review terms of reference in conjunction with scheduled major governance review in 2021.
- Calgary Transit Public Safety Citizen Oversight Committee, Social Wellbeing Advisory Committee – COVID-19 impacts to their capacity has required a request to defer review until late 2020 to 2021.

### **Reviewed But No Updates Required**

BiodiverCity Advisory Committee

#### Review and Amendment Recommended

- Advisory Committee on Accessibility –strengthened roles & conduct, and authority to adopt additional procedures.
- Calgary Transit Access Eligibility Appeal Board –strengthened roles & conduct, and authority to conduct virtual meetings.
