Previous Council Direction

In advance of the 2019 provincial election and the 2019 and 2021 federal elections, City of Calgary Administration sought and received Council's direction to prepare and conduct a YYC Matters campaign.

At that time, Council was also asked for, and provided, guidance on the key issues or themes for each campaign.


