- 3. Improved resources for police services











Bill 7: Municipal Government (Property Tax Incentives) Amendment Act • Will give municipalities the power to offer property tax incentives to business and industry. • With a single bylaw, councils can: • Offer incentives to reduce, exempt or defer collection of property taxes for non-residential properties for up to 15 years; and • Establish eligibility criteria and application processes to streamline incentives, rather than requiring separate bylaws for each property.

 - Proposed principles for a new funding model






Police Funding
