- May 2005 Wing Kei Crescent Heights opened with 89 beds now 145 beds
- October 2014 Wing Kei Greenview 1 opened with 95 supportive living beds
- November 2018 Wing Kei Greenview 2 opened with 80 long term care beds
- Total staff count is 400
- Monthly payroll cost exceeds \$1.7 million
