Definitions - High Traffic is defined as high frequency and large numerical volume of the public frequenting the building within the building's hours of operation. **Low Traffic** is defined as low frequency and small numerical volume of the public frequenting the building. Pedestrian traffic is evaluated throughout the entire day; and therefore, publicly accessible buildings with limited hours of operation will fall within the category of low/minimal traffic.

Barriers - Public Access to water within City owned buildings is limited to building hours of operation. For example, the Municipal Building is open from 6am-6pm Monday - Friday. Hours of availability for Recreation Centres and the Civic Partner facilities are generally longer and include weekend hours; although often water is only accessible by patrons of the facility. Fire Halls, although accessible to the public, do have limited public access. Hours of operation within community association buildings are further restricted as they are generally only open in the evening, a few hours during the day and/or during events. The highest degree of accessibility, based on operational hours, is within libraries (18 branches in Calgary), which are open during the week and on the weekends and have publicly accessible fountains.
