
Urban Form Categories






Bylaw Framework

Calgary A Recommendations – PUD2019-1015

That the Standing Policy Committee on Planning and Urban Development:

- 1. Direct Administration to:
 - a. prepare a bylaw for the Guidebook for Great Communities as outlined in Attachment 3; and
 - b. forward the proposed bylaw, to accommodate the required advertising, and this report, directly to the 2019 November 18 Combined meeting of Council.
- 2. Recommend that Council
 - a. hold a Public Hearing for the proposed bylaw at the 2019 November 18 Combined meeting of Council, and give three readings to the proposed Bylaw; and,
 - b. adopt, by resolution, the Framework for a Renewed Land Use Bylaw and Outline for New Districts, as contained in Attachment 4.



That the Standing Policy Committee on Planning and Urban Development:

- 1. Forward this report to the 2019 November 18 meeting of Council in order for it to be on the same agenda and heard in conjunction with (following) PUD2019-1015 *Great Communities for Everyone*; and,
- 2. Recommend that Council Direct Administration to:
 - i. Proceed with Phase 1 of the implementation schedule for the renewal of the Land Use Bylaw as proposed in Attachment 1;
 - ii. Develop implementation options for how to apply the new Limited scale Neighbourhood Housing district throughout the built-out areas; and,
 - iii. Report back through the Standing Policy Committee on Planning and Urban Development no later than Q1, 2021.
