



Actions

- Research conducted and sector strategies developed
- Increased both inbound and outbound mission activity
- Enhanced Be Part of the Energy
- Contracted site selectors and industry experts to build in market contacts
- Results to March 2017: 53 investments 1950 jobs
 - 250 leads
 - Talent Hub: 6 investments 65 jobs
 - Headquarter Attraction: 6 investments 85 jobs
 - Renewable Energy: 8 investments 230 jobs
 - Transportation and Logistics: 3 investments 625 jobs
 - Film and Television: 12 film projects 725 jobs
 - Agribusiness: 3 investments 195 jobs
 - Global Business Centre and Energy: 15 investments 25 jobs



collaboration and success stories

Calgary Economic Development hosted the third Economic Summit. The 2017 Summit focused on opportunities in Transportation and Logistics, Agribusiness and Innovation. Key themes from the Summit influencing the Economic Strategy include:

- Address road and transit collaboration across municipal boundaries
- Increase focus on technology in Transportation
- Align and rationalize the regulatory environment for Agribusiness
- Strengthen linkages between research, innovation and businesses to advance opportunities in smart agriculture
- Develop agribusiness accelerator, incubation facilities, programs or agrizone
- Support technology and innovation across all sectors
- Work with provincial government to support policies facilitating access to capital
- Build a culture of innovation (Rainforest)



- Calgarians understanding of the root causes of poverty doubled





Sense of Community


Percentage of Calgarians who are satisfied with the overall level and quality of City services and programs




Percentage of Calgarians regularly involved in neighbourhood and community events




Percentage of Canadians in national perceptions research ranking overall perceptions of Calgary as favourable



Percentage of Calgarians agreeing that overall quality of life is good




Percentage of Calgarians agreeing that Calgary is a great place to make a life








Sustainable Development and Purposeful Diversification






Non-oil and gas diversification score

**Overall gross domestic product (GDP) for all industries








Percentage of Calgarians agreeing that Calgary is a great place to make a living




***Percentage of all people in Calgary living at or below Low Income Cut off Before Tax




***The City of Calgary now reports Low Income Measure after tax. The new measure is reported here.

Percentage of Calgary households spending more than they can afford on housing (32% of gross family income)




Overall employment rate of Calgarians
