

The City of Calgary Low Income Programs and Services

Common Proofs of Income Eligibility

The following proofs of income are now accepted by all City of Calgary Low-Income Programs and Services and represent a significant enhancement to establishing consistent expectations for low-income customers.

The low-income programs continue to work to expand the number of acceptable proofs of income and improve access for low-income Calgarians. Additionally, low-income programs and services work closely with applicants to facilitate access for those who may have difficulty with providing proofs of income from this list (e.g. letter from veterinarian for Animal and Bylaw Services No Cost Spay Neuter Clinic).

Acceptable Proofs of Income Eligibility Include:

- **Canada Revenue Agency - Notice of Assessment**
- **Alberta Works : Income Subsidy/Support (Supports for Independence)**
- **Alberta Works: Adult Health Benefit**
- **Assured Income for Severely Handicapped benefits**
- **Alberta Works: Learners Benefit**
- **Alberta Works: Child Health Benefit**
- **Letter from Registered Social Worker**
- **Resettlement Assistance Program form**
- **For independent youth: a letter from school principal or guidance counsellor, or letter from Child and Youth Support Program of Alberta Children's Services**
