Withdrawal of Application LOC2019-0151, CPC2019-1460

PURPOSE OF BRIEFING

Subsequent to the 2019 December 19 date of Calgary Planning Commissions decision to recommend refusal of application LOC2019-0151, the applicant has notified Administration of their withdrawal of the application prior to the decision of Council. As a result of withdrawal, this application and the recommendation of Calgary Planning Commission will not proceed to Council or be advertised for the February 3 Combined Meeting of Council.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

The decision of an applicant to withdraw an application subsequent to the Calgary Planning Commission decision is supported by Section 17(2) and (3) of the Land use Bylaw as follows:

- 17 (2) Calgary Planning Commission must communicate its decision to the applicant, who must decide whether to pursue his application to a public hearing before *Council*.
 - (3) Should the applicant decide not to pursue the application to *Council*, the application is abandoned and the advertising component of the fees will be refunded.
