BYLAW NUMBER 2B2020

BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CALGARY
TO INCUR INDEBTEDNESS
BY THE ISSUANCE OF DEBENTURES
IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$4.022 MILLION
FOR FINANCING THE ACQUISITION OF
FLEET AND EQUIPMENT
FOR THE REGULATED OPERATIONS
OF ENMAX CORPORATION

WHEREAS Council of The City of Calgary ("Council") has reviewed the 2020 Consolidated Operating and Capital Budget for ENMAX Corporation, a controlled corporation of The City of Calgary ("The City");

AND WHEREAS the acquisition of fleet and equipment for the regulated operations of ENMAX Corporation (the "**Acquisitions**") are estimated to cost \$6.385 million;

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that \$2.363 million of the total cost will be financed from sources other than debenture borrowing;

AND WHEREAS Council has decided to pass a bylaw pursuant to sections 251 and 258 of the <u>Municipal Government Act</u>, RSA 2000, c M-26 to borrow the sum of \$4.022 million from Alberta Capital Finance Authority ("**ACFA**") by the issuance of debentures to finance the Acquisitions;

AND WHEREAS the estimated lifetime of the project financed under this Bylaw is equal to, or in excess of, ten (10) years;

AND WHEREAS all required approvals for the Acquisitions will be obtained to ensure they are in compliance with all the laws in force in the Province of Alberta;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALGARY, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The proper officers of The City are hereby authorized to issue debentures on behalf of The City to a maximum sum of \$4.022 million to finance the Acquisitions.
- 2. The City shall repay the indebtedness over a period not exceeding ten (10) years in semiannual equal principal and interest installments, with interest being calculated at a rate not exceeding the rate fixed by ACFA on the date of the borrowing, up to a maximum rate of 8% per annum.
- 3. The City shall obtain funds from ENMAX Corporation to repay the said indebtedness under the terms of the agreement between The City and ENMAX Corporation, as described in Bylaw No. 6M2020. In the event of any revenue deficiency, The City shall levy and raise municipal taxes sufficient to pay the indebtedness.



The indebtedness shall be contracted on the credit and security of The City.
