Rules for waterpipe vs. smoking/vaping

A majority of 63% in Calgary say the rules for public use of water pipes should be the same as for smoking and vaping. Very few say the rules should be less restrictive, but this view is more common among younger Calgarians and those who feel the current smoking/vaping rules are too restrictive.

If waterpipe smoking should be allowed

As with smoking and vaping, majorities say waterpipes should not be allowed in parks, at outdoor concerts or public transit stops, and there are mixed opinions about allowing them in designated hotel rooms. However, two-thirds say they should be allowed in public places such as artist lounges.

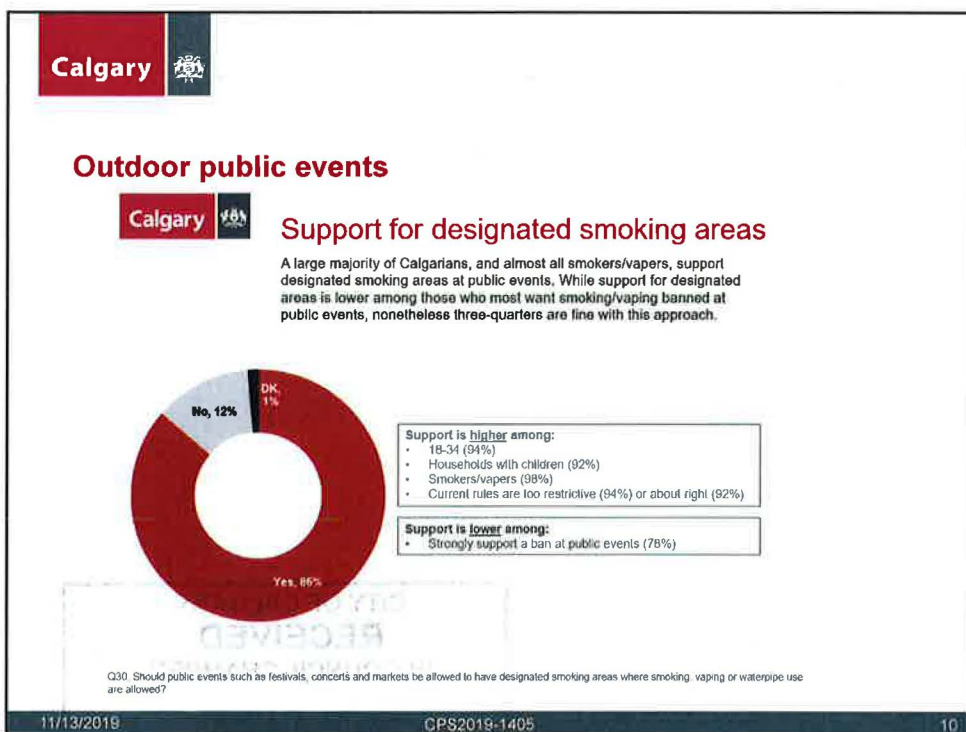
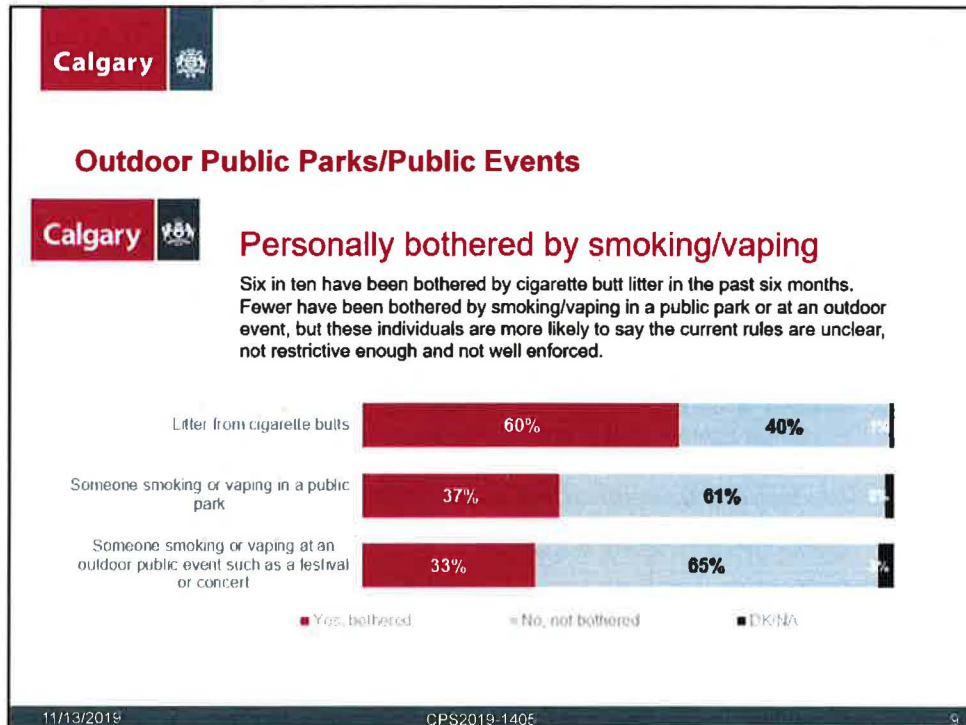
