Thank you Bev.

Due to some things that arose today, I was unable to prepare something on behalf of NAIOP Calgary, but we support BILD Calgary's concerns as articulated.

While we understand the Administration would like to seek advice from Council, we would agree with BILD that the current amount of information, particularly on Layer 2, is insufficient for any formal consideration at this time. We would suggest that more work needs to be done on this policy, and that broader stakeholder engagement of potentially affected property owners be undertaken as well. While we recognize that the Admin has been consulting with heritage advocacy folks, some community associations, BILD, NAIOP and others, we don't believe that potentially affected property owners who could see their properties effectively downzoned or restricted without their consideration or input to be appropriate. There are potentially thousands of impacted owners, and we are unaware of any material engagement with those property owners.

This should be to be done prior to policy consideration to seek their input directly, and not after during potential "guideline discussions" afterwards, as there is potentially no consideration at this time in this policy initiative for property owners potentially affected by Layer 2 to "opt out".


