Subject: Naming of the Officer's Mess Gardens, Currie Barracks, Calgary

We have received your inquiry of April 26, 2017 regarding the naming of the formal gardens associated with the Officer's Mess Provincial Historic Resource at the Currie Barracks site in Calgary. Our historical research on the site has not revealed any formally recognized name for the garden. The garden appears to have been referred to throughout the history of the site as the "officer's mess gardens".

Lacking any formal name, for documentation and interpretation purposes, such as the listing of the Officer's Mess on the Alberta Register of Historic Places (https://hermis.alberta.ca/ARHP/) and the Canadian Register of Historic Places (www.historicplaces.ca), Alberta Culture and Tourism will continue to refer to the garden as the Officer's Mess Gardens as that name appears to be closest in keeping with the historical understanding of the landscape feature.
