Four Categories of Concerns

Category of Concern	Recommended Action
Re-Drawing Historical Watershed Boundaries for Fish Creek & Pine Creek	The City needs to know what the impacts and costs are to re-drawing the watershed boundaries are before this decision is finalized as part of the MDP, and is part of the basis for the Providence ASP
Surface Water / Stormwater	Incorporate in the Providence MDP the 3 rd Party Review recommendations to “oversize” the stormwater infrastructure to accommodate climate change and other impacts



Category of Concern	Recommended Action
Sub-surface Groundwater	The City should have better information before the Providence ASP and the accompanying MDP are approved, with regard to the impacts that will occur from stripping off the source water, preventing groundwater recharge (due to lined storm ponds), then piping the water directly to Fish Creek; revise the MDP wording to require “no adverse impacts” from proposed changes to the water flows to Tsuut’ina lands and to any other lands



Category of Concern	Recommended Action
Biodiversity	Ensure Best Management Practices are implemented to protect species at risk and key wildlife habitat; conduct further studies to minimize, or negate, any negative impacts on sensitive environmental features and their functions. For example, assessment needs to be undertaken to determine what areas should <u>not</u> be easily accessed by people (and their dogs)
