PREVIOUS COUNCIL DIRECTION / POLICY

A Motion Arising (Attachment) was moved at the 2017 June 12 Regular Meeting of Council by Councillor Demong after reviewing Report CPC2017-188 (a land use amendment supported by an outline plan). The Motions Arising directed Administration to examine the west Macleod Trail quadrant boundary alignment, and report on the impact of moving the current quadrant boundary eastward from its current alignment on Sheriff King Street to Macleod Trail.

BACKGROUND
