Peace Estates-Inglewood Barrier	Design and construction of low height barrier to provide flood protection. Project includes community engagement.	\$ 1,100	N
Northwest Inner City - Upper Plateau Separation	Partial separation of Hillhurst-Sunnyside's stormwater system from the communities located in the upper plateau.	\$ 36,900	N
9th Avenue Bridge Project	Raising of the 9th Avenue Bridge above the 100-year flood level to prevent damage during high water events, maintain access into Inglewood for Fire and Emergency Services, and addition of erosion protection and bank stabilization to prevent flooding into east Inglewood.	\$ 6,300	Y
