
Background



- October, 2016 - 40 Avenue North Green Line charrette held with results summarized in Highland Village Green report.
- January 23, 2017 - Council directed Administration to prepare a scoping report to identify the requirements associated with an ARP for Highland Park.
- March 20, 2017 - Highland Village Green land use amendment application (LOC2014-0190) approved.



Background



Highland Park Community

- Predominantly low-density single and semi-detached housing
- Multi-residential, mixed-use and commercial development on Centre Street and 4 Street.
- Neighbourhood activity centre at Centre Street and 40 Avenue
- Population (2016) – 4,014 (-18%)
- Peak Population (1969) – 4,875
