Composition	<p>1 Chairman jointly appointed by The City and the Authority</p> <p>2 Members appointed by The City*</p> <p>2 Members appointed by the Calgary Airport Authority</p> <p>*NOTE: As per the appeal process outlined in The Agreement, when an appeal arises, The City and the Airport Authority will each appoint two members to the Appeal body, all for that specific appeal. These members should have experience in the type of issue under appeal.</p>
