

Proposed Council Direction

1. Proceed with negotiations required to implement an Administrative Penalties System;
2. *Bring forward Council Innovation Fund application to PFC for one-time startup costs;*
3. Engage key stakeholders on establishing an Administrative Penalties System (APS); and,
4. Develop Administrative Penalties Bylaw, and other related and necessary bylaw amendments, and present them at Public Hearing in 2020.





Standard of Proof Beyond a reasonable doubt	On a balance of probabilities
Procedure Court rules of procedure apply	As provided by City Charter Regulation, Bylaw, or as determined by tribunal
Public Participation Lengthy in person process, with waiting and delays.	Online appeal filing. Average 15 minute hearing within one-hour booking time.
City Resources Required Prosecutor and Enforcement Officer(s), in person	Evidence by affidavit. Enforcement Officer(s) only when requested by appellant
