Financial and Other Resource Capacity

The Tomorrow's Chinatown project already includes engagement with the Chinatown community and with an advisory committee to discuss the culture and history of Chinatown. This process can be leveraged to cost-effectively discuss the history of the Short Site and determine new name recommendations from the community. Costs may be incurred for subsequent programming and on-site interpretation of the historical learnings from the community discussions. These costs can be reviewed at time of report back on the proposed name(s).

It is within Council's authority to change the names of these municipal properties. Council cannot compel a name change for the James Short Memorial School but can request the Mayor write a letter to the Calgary Board of Education, which is a request of the community groups consulted on the writing of this Notice of Motion.

Community residents brought forward this initial request. The Chinatown Community Association, Chinatown Business Improvement Area, Sien Lok Society, and Calgary Chinese Cultural Centre were then engaged to solicit advice. All supported pursuing with the name change and requested Tomorrow's Chinatown be leveraged to recommend new names.
Administration was consulted on the drafting of the Notice of Motion and the Calgary Parking Authority is aware of the proposal. Administration is supportive of pursuing this work and no concerns were raised from the Calgary Parking Authority.
