BACKGROUND

The Livery Transport Advisory Committee (LTAC) provides advice and recommendations to Council to ensure high quality livery transport services and to create and maintain a sustainable industry as specified in the <u>Livery Transport Bylaw</u>, 6M2007. The objective is to ensure public safety, service quality and consumer protection for customers and service providers.

The full composition of LTAC is eighteen members, appointed by resolution of Council, including one representative from the Calgary Police Service (non-voting). In accordance with the LTAC Terms of Reference, each member may be appointed by Council for a one or two year term, effective the date of the annual Organizational Meeting of Council. LTAC's current member composition is detailed in Attachment 1.

INVESTIGATION: ALTERNATIVES AND ANALYSIS

On 2017 April 26, the City Clerk's Office received notification that the Calgary Policy Service is proposing the appointment of Sergeant Ken Richards to replace the current member representing the Calgary Police Service on LTAC, effective immediately. The nomination is detailed in Attachment 2.
