LRT stations providing links to destinations across Calgary:

- 11 Transit hubs
Connecting many bus routes with frequent service
- 4 Bus rapid transit (BRT) connections
Fast, reliable, limited stop services with dedicated lanes
- 8 Primary transit connections
Service every 10 minutes, 15 hours daily, 7 days a week
- 4 Regional connections
Transit routes between Calgary and surrounding communities

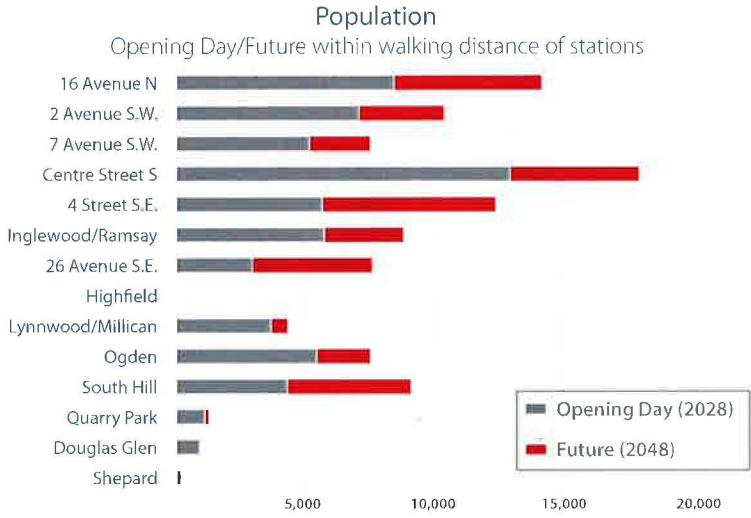
Quick facts

- 20 Km of LRT track
- 14 Stations
- 8 Bridges
- 1 Km of elevated track
- 3 Park and Ride facilities with approximately 1,900 stalls
- 3 Tunnels
- 4 Km Centre City tunnel
- 70 Low floor vehicles
- 1 Maintenance and storage facility
- \$4.65B Capital construction cost

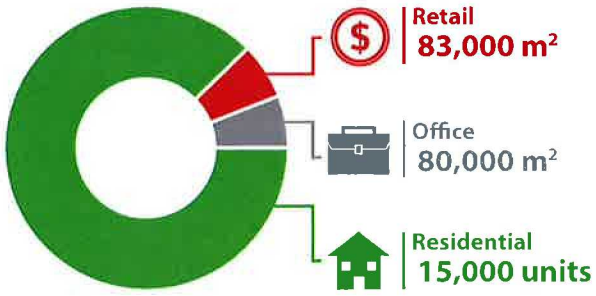

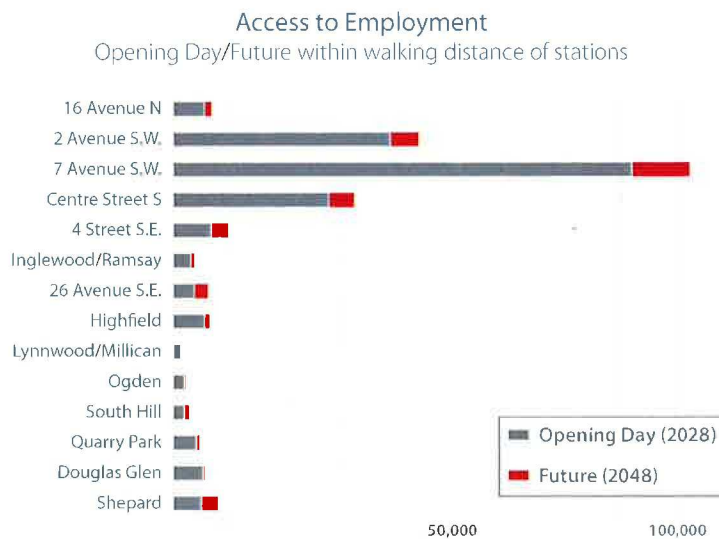
Benefits to Calgarians

- 225,500 Future jobs (2048)



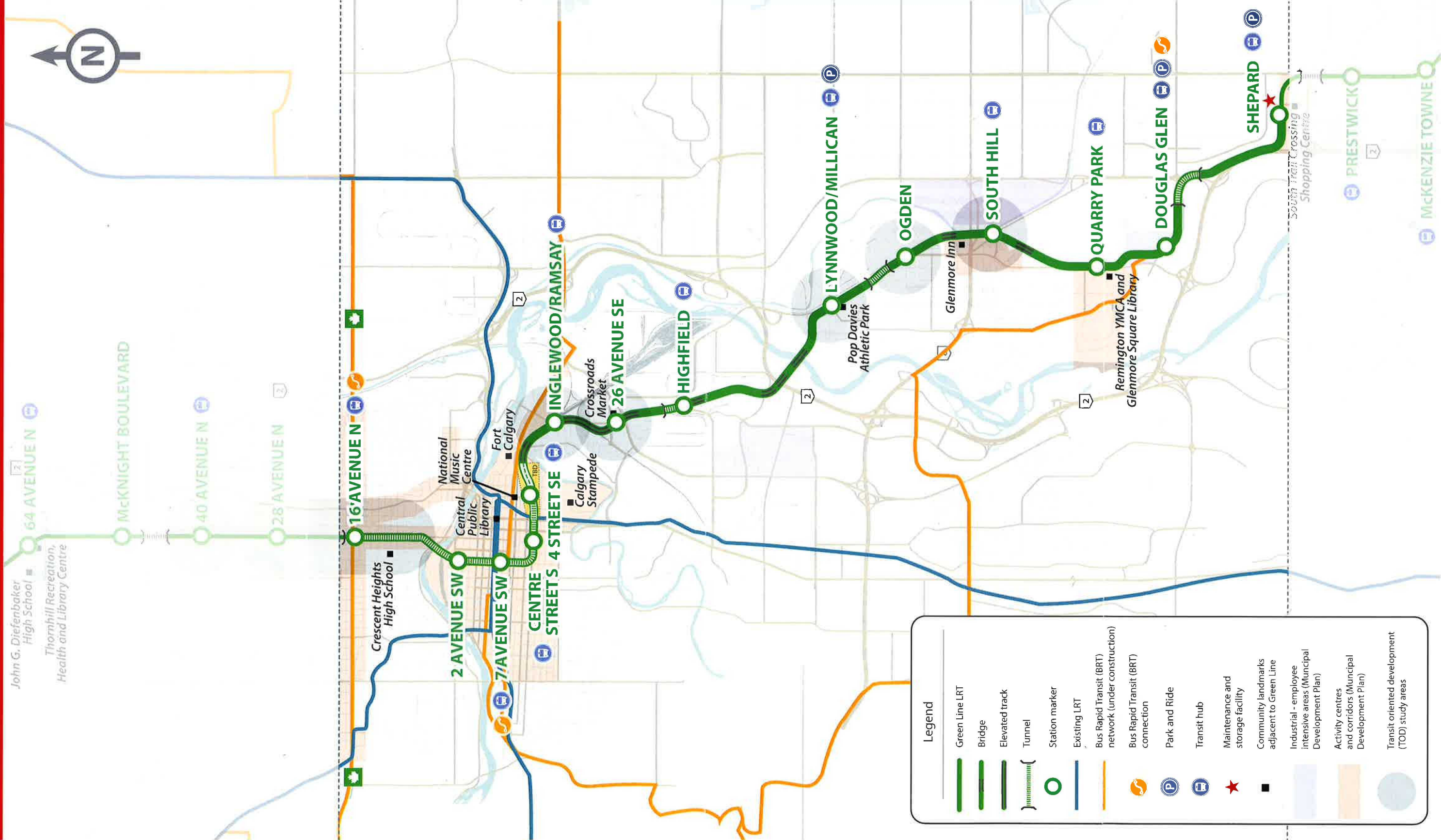
Environmental

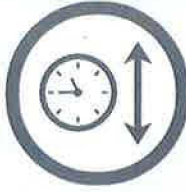

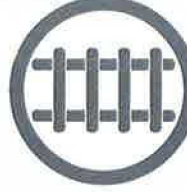
