

Airport Vicinity Protection Area (AVPA) Regulation

Purpose of the Regulation

To provide guidance on land use decisions that are compatible with Airport operations, using:

- AVPA Boundary
- Noise exposure Forecast (NEF) Contours

AVPA is a regulation within the Municipal Government Act and administered in partnership between the Calgary Airport Authority and The City of Calgary

Background

2016	The City of Calgary and Calgary Airport Authority begin reviewing opportunities for regulation changes
2018	Formation of the AVPA Committee to guide the work
2019	Ministerial approval provided additional opportunities for low density residential in specific communities.
Today	Proposal to update NEF Contours to maximize effectiveness in land use decision making

Why Update the AVPA?


- Major advances in aviation technology over the last 40 years

Independent Third Party Review to update NEF contours


Key Changes:

- Addressing areas where NEF Contour restriction has increased






NEF Contour Changes – Illustrated





NEF Contour Increase




Affected by NEF Increase

2084 total parcels (227 hectares)

2029 parcels (178 hectares) – move into NEF25 Resulting in the only restriction applied being a campground

55 parcels (49 hectares) – move into NEF30 & 35 Resulting in significant additional use restrictions

Administration Recommendations (REVISED)

That the SPC on Planning and Urban Development recommend that Council:

- Approve by resolution the proposed Calgary International Airport
 Vicinity Projection Area Regulation changes outlined in attachment
 5, directing Administration to submit a joint amendment application
 with the Calgary Airport Authority to the Minister of Municipal
 Affairs; and
- 2. Disband the working group formed through Council resolution 2018 December 17 (PUD2018-1400), known as the AVPA Committee and acknowledge the completion of its mandate.

And further, that an update on the third party review of the AVPA boundary be included in the package moving forward to Council.
