Purpose of this update

Current context

- 1. Strategic growth areas exist across the city
- Growth requires partnership and coordination of public and private investment
- 3. City-wide growth strategy considers when and where growth should be enabled, and how to pay for it
- 4. The Municipal Development Plan / Calgary Transportation Plan has set a direction for compact urban form, choice in mobility, and a balanced growth strategy – there have been successes
- 5. Economic uncertainty and changing markets lead to increased risk
- 6. Downward pressure on property taxes, grants, and capital for The City, and on development costs for industry
- 7. New ways to fund and implement the vision are required



Key themes for consideration

- 1. Great places help drive economic recovery
- 2. Growth in our city is changing our responses must change as well
- 3. Growth investments are a matter of policy and budget choices
- The City is an active participant in growth decisions should consider city-wide priorities, tradeoffs and opportunities
- 5. Return on investment is financial, social and environmental
- 6. Benefits of strategic growth can be reinvested, helping attract capital and additional growth
- Policy and process improvements will be necessary to achieve growth objectives and enable private investment
- Growth enabling City investment may be less about quantity, and more about strategy and partnerships
