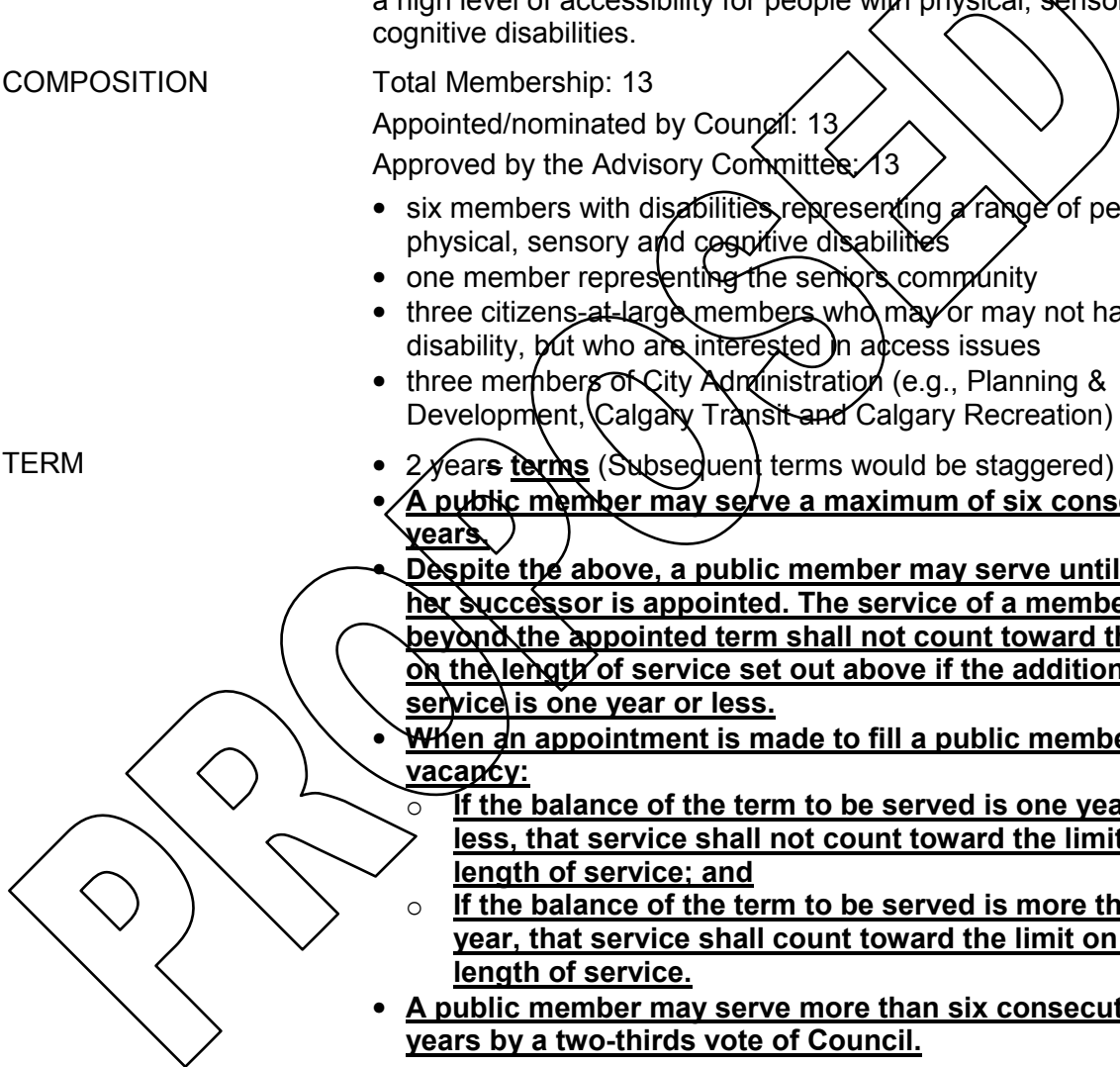

COMMITTEE	Advisory Committee on Accessibility (ACA)
AUTHORITY	Resolution of Council 1999 May 03 TTP99-19 (HET99-19)
TERMS OF REFERENCE	To make recommendations to City Council through the SPC on Community & Protective Services on policy and systems issues impacting people with disabilities. To be a resource to City Council and City Administration in addressing physical, transportation, communication, social and economic accessibility issues to provide a high level of accessibility for people with physical, sensory and cognitive disabilities.
COMPOSITION	Total Membership: 13 Appointed/nominated by Council: 13 Approved by the Advisory Committee: 13 <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• six members with disabilities representing a range of people with physical, sensory and cognitive disabilities</li><li>• one member representing the seniors community</li><li>• three citizens-at-large members who may or may not have a disability, but who are interested in access issues</li><li>• three members of City Administration (e.g., Planning &amp; Development, Calgary Transit and Calgary Recreation)</li></ul>
TERM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2 years <u>terms</u> (Subsequent terms would be staggered)</li><li>• <b><u>A public member may serve a maximum of six consecutive years.</u></b></li><li>• <b><u>Despite the above, a public member may serve until his or her successor is appointed. The service of a member beyond the appointed term shall not count toward the limit on the length of service set out above if the additional service is one year or less.</u></b></li><li>• <b><u>When an appointment is made to fill a public member vacancy:</u></b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ <b><u>If the balance of the term to be served is one year or less, that service shall not count toward the limit on the length of service; and</u></b></li><li>○ <b><u>If the balance of the term to be served is more than one year, that service shall count toward the limit on the length of service.</u></b></li></ul></li><li>• <b><u>A public member may serve more than six consecutive years by a two-thirds vote of Council.</u></b></li></ul>
