COMMITTEE	Calgary Transit Access Eligibility Appeal Board
AUTHORITY	Resolution of Council (1999 April 26)
TERMS OF REFERENCE	To hear appeal from individuals who are determined to be either ineligible or conditionally eligible for specialized transportation services and individuals suspended or denied services
COMPOSITION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 members with disabilities using specialized transportation services;• 1 citizen-at-large; and• 2 health care practitioners (e. g., medical doctor, occupational or physical therapist, rehabilitation specialist)
TERM	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 year <u>term</u>• <u>A member may serve a maximum of six consecutive years.</u>• <u>Despite the above, a member may serve until his or her successor is appointed. The service of a member beyond the appointed term shall not count toward the limit on the length of service set out above if the additional service is one year or less.</u>• <u>When an appointment is made to fill a member vacancy:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">○ <u>If the balance of the term to be served is one year or less, that service shall not count toward the limit on the length of service; and</u>○ <u>If the balance of the term to be served is more than one year, that service shall count toward the limit on the length of service.</u>• <u>A public member may serve more than six consecutive years by a two-thirds vote of Council.</u>
