We have considered the comments raised on 2017 January 11 by members of the Standing Policy Committee on Planning and Urban Development with respect to the process improvements portion of The Industry/City Work Plan. In advance of the report coming to Council on 2017 January 23, our staff have met with Councillors Demong and Stevenson to further clarify their specific concerns. The three comments that were brought forward will be addressed through the 13 projects currently underway.

1. Development permit extensions and renewals comment will be addressed through the *Permit Coordination* project.
2. Performance security reduction for development agreements will be addressed as part of the *CCG/FAC* project.
3. Commitments made during the approvals process will be addressed as part of the *Explore and Pre-application Meetings* project.
