Community & Protective Services on policy and systems issues impacting people with disabilities. To be a resource to City Council and City Administration in addressing physical, transportation, communication, social and economic accessibility issues to provide a high level of accessibility for people with physical, sensory and

cognitive disabilities.

COMPOSITION Total Membership: 13

Appointed/nominated by Coungil: 13,

Approved by the Advisory Committee: 13

 six members with disabilities representing a range of people with physical, sensory and cognitive disabilities

• one member representing the seniors community

 three citizens-at-large members who may or may not have a disability, but who are interested in access issues

 three members of City Administration (e.g., Planning & Development, Calgary Transit and Calgary Recreation)

• 2 years terms (Subsequent terms would be staggered)

A public member may serve a maximum of six consecutive

vears.

Despite the above, a public member may serve until his or her successor is appointed. The service of a member beyond the appointed term shall not count toward the limit on the length of service set out above if the additional service is one year or less.

When an appointment is made to fill a public member vacancy:

less, that service shall not count toward the limit on the length of service; and

 If the balance of the term to be served is more than one year, that service shall count toward the limit on the length of service.

• A public member may serve more than six consecutive years by a two-thirds vote of Council.

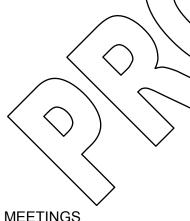
