The service of a member beyond the appointed term shall not count toward the limit on the length of service set out above if the additional service is one year or less. When an appointment is made to fill a member vacancy: If the balance of the term to be served is one year or less, that service shall not count toward the limit on the length of service; and If the balance of the term to be served is more than one year, that service shall count toward the limit on the length of service.
