

2019 Highlights

- 102% increase in grant investments
- \$10+ million invested in hundreds of individual artists, arts collectives, and arts organizations
- \$663,665 invested through Cultural Activation Fund
- 3.2 million attendees
- \$131 million in direct economic output
- 1,064 additional jobs created


Arts organizations supported +23% Artists hired +15% Arts workers hired +24% Activities in city centre +31% Direct economic output +5%

Activities engaging multicultural communities +46% Activities engaging Indigenous communities +10% Attendance at arts events +8% Volunteer hours +16%


Youth Impact

Attendance of children and youth +2% First time youth attendance has increased since 2013 when it started to decline year after year





Current State: Impact of COVID-19



The Arts Industry is in crisis

- 88% of organizations cancelled or postponed performances
- 81% of artist contracts cancelled
- 84% of arts organizations reported the financial impact as significant or major
- Staffing levels dropped by 53%
- 89% of organizations anticipate the arts will be in a worse position in a year
