1.	For the recast of the Events Centre budget for the future years, is this a reflection of a change in the work schedule and timelines? If so, what are the reasons why, and will this change impact the opening of the facility?	The proposed changes are being made to align with the overall cash flow for the Event Centre project as project planning has progressed and does not change the 50/50 partnership between The City and Calgary Sports and Entertainment Corporation. The schedule remains as is with the building completion date of May 2024.

4.	Can members of Council have access to the SAVE business cases that were not approved by ELT?	There were two business cases that were not approved by ELT to be included in the MCA package and have been moved to Wave 2. These are provided to members of Council in Appendix 1 - Confidential. The rationale for not making these public at this time is that both cases require further analysis, and it would not be appropriate to share incomplete work publicly.
