Reinvested revenues may be used for the following purposes in a given area. Note, additional initiatives not listed below may be proposed for consideration by The City of Calgary.

- Mobility-related capital items, including:
  - o Streetlights (e.g. decorative poles, pedestrian lighting)
  - Transit Furniture (including shelters and benches)
  - o Sidewalks
  - Bollards or gates
  - Bicycle racks
  - Crosswalk and intersection treatments
  - Way-finding infrastructure
  - o On-street parking configurations
  - Traffic calming measures
  - Accessibility improvements
- Public realm-related capital items, including:
  - Waste and recycling receptacles
  - Street Furniture
  - Planters and flower baskets
  - Experiential lighting programs (e.g. lighting of facades, features)
  - o Banners
  - o Public Art
  - o Trees and tree grates
  - o Fences
  - o Retaining walls
  - o Low-impact development solutions
  - Burying or relocation of public utilities (must be to improve public realm and not for other purposes).
- Enhanced annual operational services, including:
  - o Graffiti Abatement
  - o Waste collection
  - o Snow clearing and removal
  - Street sweeping
  - Pressure washing
  - Planting of flowers
  - o Boulevard maintenance, such as mowing or weed control
- Planning or studies facilitating any of the above objectives
- City of Calgary staff time to support implementation of the above
