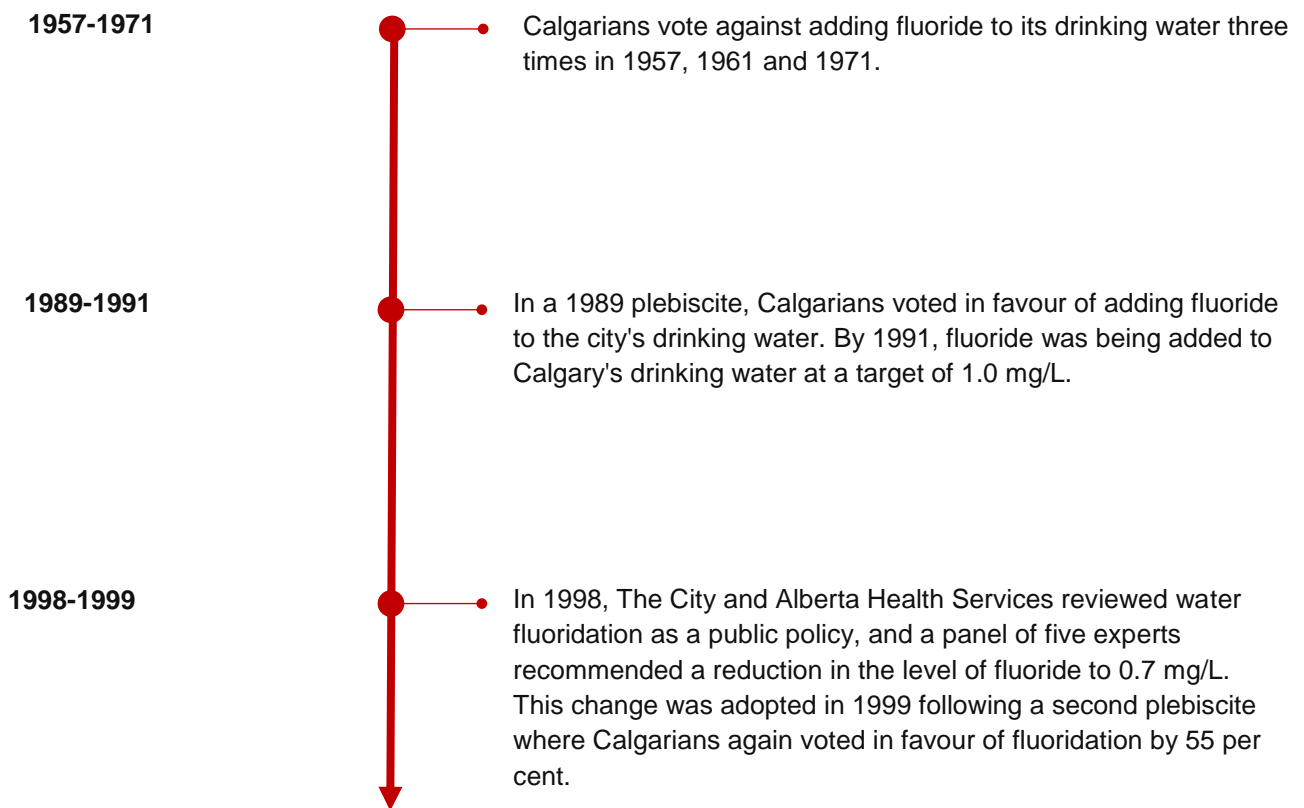
Context
