

Proposed Amendments to Bylaw 49P2020

Prior to second reading amend bylaw 49P2020 by amending Schedule “A” as follows:

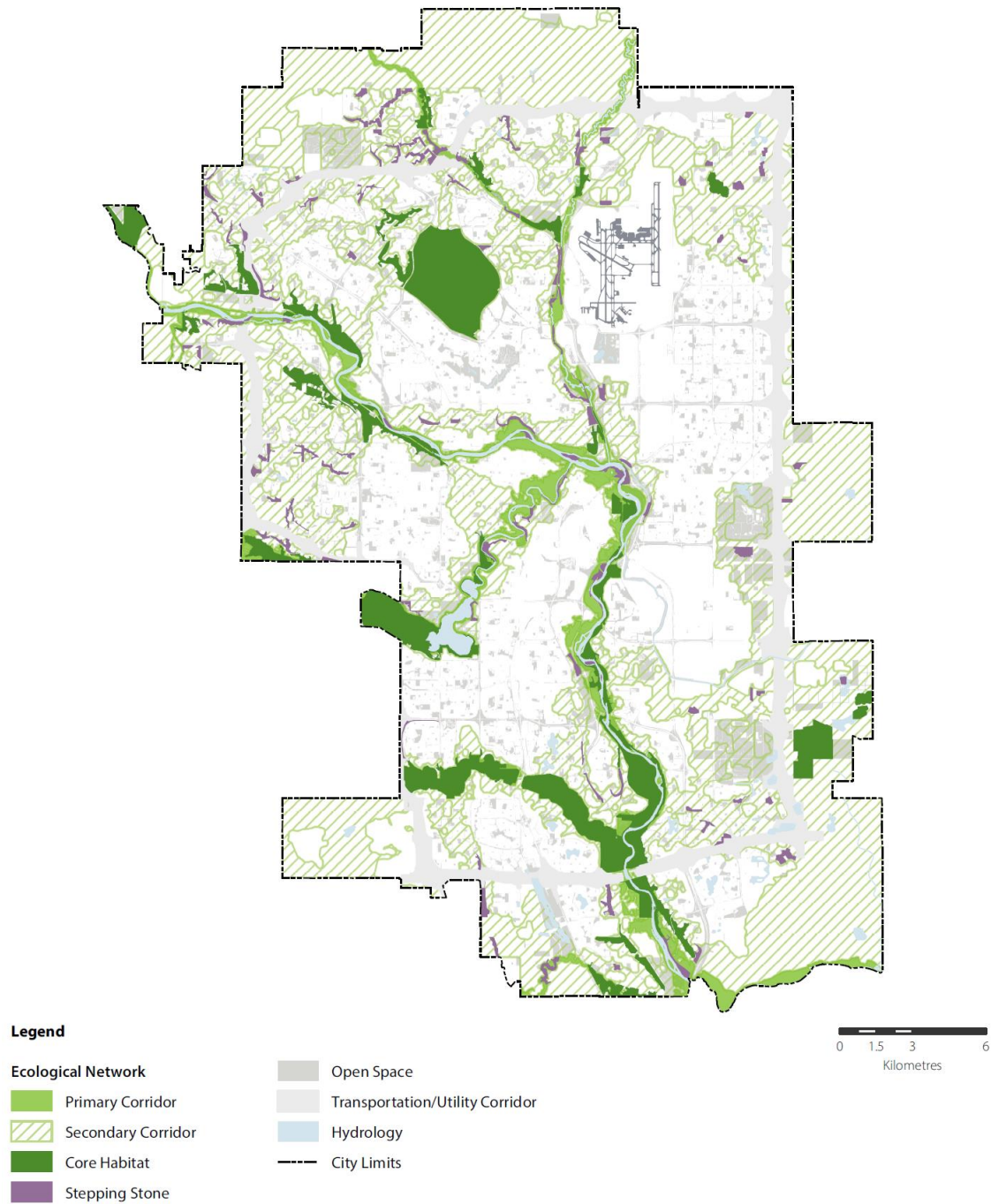

51	43	<p>Add new sentence in the second paragraph, after the second sentence, under section 2.3.4 (Parks, Open Spaces and Outdoor Recreation) with the following: “Map 4 represents the Parks and Open Space system in Calgary.”</p> <p>This edit provides additional clarity on natural areas and open space in Calgary.</p>
77	69	<p>Replace third and fourth sentences in the first paragraph under section 2.6.4 (Ecological Networks) with the following: “The river systems along with Calgary’s natural areas and regional parks form the backbone of the network. Other open spaces such as neighbourhood and linear parks, boulevards and community gardens make an important contribution in urban areas providing valuable resources for plant and animal species. Figure 2-7 provides an example of key components that form part of Calgary’s ecological network.”</p> <p>This edit clarifies the role of supporting natural components in the broader ecological network.</p>
77	69	<p>Replace the third and fourth sentences in the second paragraph under section 2.6.4 (Ecological Networks) with the following: “Figure 2-8 depicts Calgary’s ecological network, delineated through spatial network theory and supported by a range of City policies, principles and strategies including the Biodiversity Policy, Wetlands Policy, Urban Forestry Strategic Plan, Urban Parks Master Plan and Open Space Plan.”</p> <p>This edit provides a more accurate reference to Calgary’s ecological network and adds reference to The City of Calgary Biodiversity Policy.</p>
78	70	<p>Replace the first and second sentences of the third paragraph under section 2.6.4 (Ecological Networks) with the following: “The real power of natural areas and open spaces – and their ability to significantly improve the quality of life for all species – lies in viewing and managing them as a system, rather than as individual components. Natural areas and open spaces can be viewed as a pattern of landscape elements, patches and corridors, that join together to form a mosaic.”</p> <p>This edit provides greater focus on natural components, while removing references to recreation. Wording is updated to more appropriately reference how components of natural systems are interconnected.</p>

78	70	Replace the fourth paragraph under section 2.6.4 (Ecological Networks) with the following: "The Ecological Network Typology categorizes major ecological components based on their contribution to the overall network. These categories combined provide an evaluation framework to determine the value of the ecological network and the associated sensitivities that should be considered prior to any development and/or activities occurring." This edit replaces outdated reference to the Open Space Typology and updates it to Ecological Network Typology.
79	71	Replace Figure 2.8 with updated Figure 2.8 (see page 3). Changes include adding the Transportation Utility Corridor and improving the resolution and clarity of the map.
80	72	Replace the title of the information bubble under section 2.6.4 (Ecological Networks) with the following: "Ecological Network Typology."
84	76	Delete the third paragraph: "The Principles of the Climate Resilience Strategy approved by Council on March 21, 2018 (C2018-0340) will guide the mainstreaming of climate specific decision-making into policies, programs and projects. The Climate Goals stipulate the key aspects to achieve over time to reach the 2050 Target of 80 per cent reduction in GHG emissions." This paragraph is redundant with similar text contained in paragraph 5 on the same page, and was retained in error. The intention of the policy and its role in guiding decision making is not reduced from eliminating paragraph 3.
85	77	Energy intensity map should refer to Figure 2-12
87	79	Amend figure 2-11 so the tree under the 'winter' diagram does not contain leaves.
143	135	The criteria for "Community Interest" under policy c should be separated out from "Landowner Interest" criteria ix, and given a new number x. Existing criteria x should be renumbered to be xi.
171	163	Replace Map 4 with updated Map 4 (see page 4). Changes include a revised title to better describe the contents, elimination of the urban structure layer to improve clarity and updating the map legend.

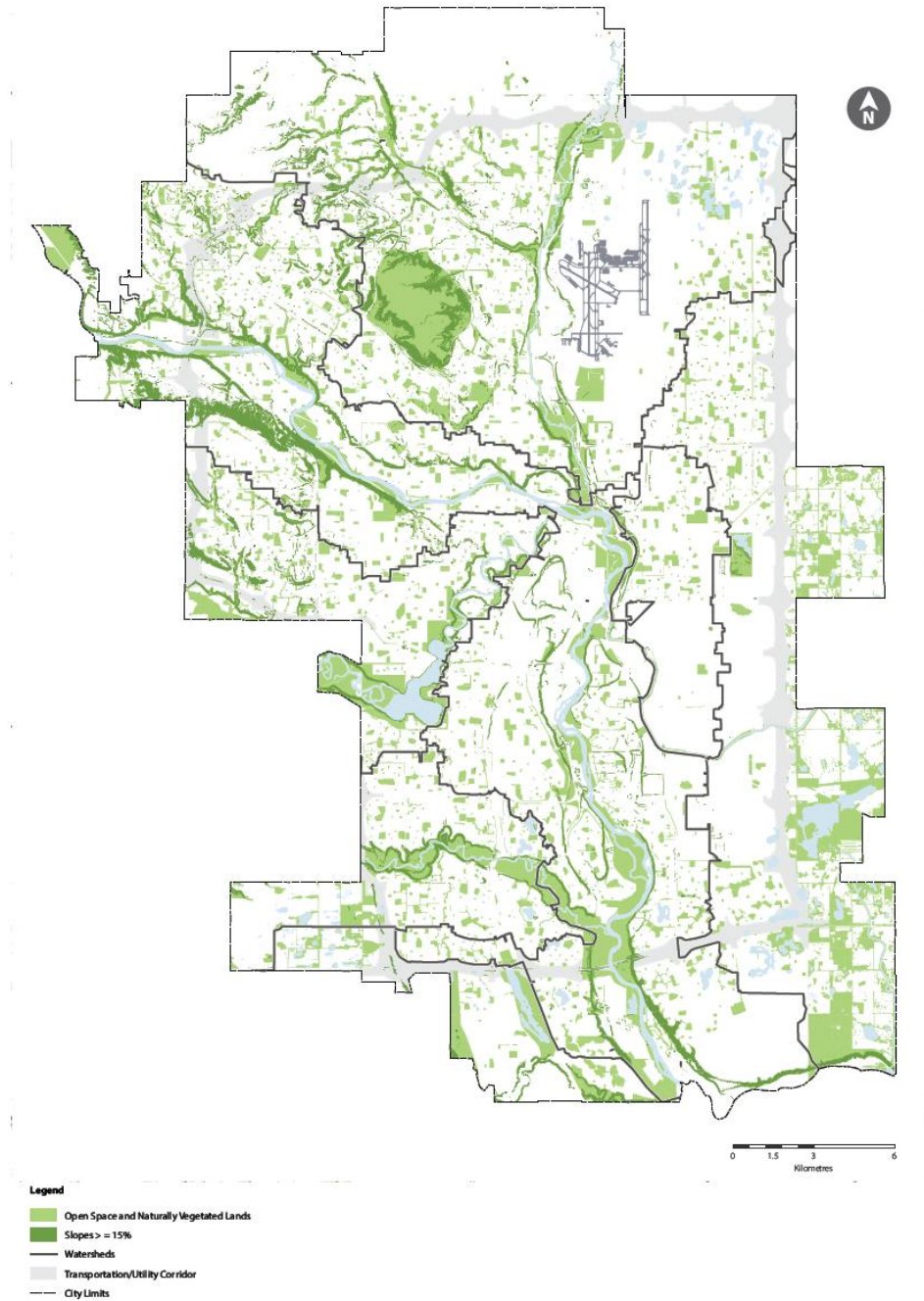

189	11	Delete the words "associated with" in the second sentence under "aligned decision-making" as they are redundant.
262	84	The definitions for "deep utility" and "design indicators" are mismatched and should be swapped to be correct.
270	92	Replace Map 1 with updated Map 1 (see page 5). Changes include increasing map readability, eliminating the current ASP layer and a note indicating that existing routes may need upgrades to meet 5A standards.
