




Why We Are Here:

Council directed Administration to prepare a Vote on a Question ("ballot questions") for the 2021 General Election, related to reintroducing fluoridation as part of the Water Treatment process.



Considerations to Reintroducing Fluoridation

- Estimated Cost to reintroduce fluoridation over 20year lifecycle is \$30.1 million plus \$2-4 million in additional non-scheduled Plant maintenance activities.
- Current operating and capital budgets do not include the costs associated with drinking water fluoridation.
 Should Council direct this work in the future, a budget request will be prepared.
- If Council was to direct Administration to proceed with water fluoridation, it is estimated that it would take 18-24 months to implement.
- The City has the authority to conduct a plebiscite regarding fluoridation if Council so chooses.





Potential Vote on the Questions

Administration is proposing the following questions for Council's consideration:

- 1. Should The City of Calgary reintroduce fluoride to the drinking water system?
- 2. Should fluoride be added to drinking water in Calgary?
- 3. Are you in favour of adding fluoride to drinking water in Calgary?
