Re: Designation of Cliff Bungalow School as a Municipal Historic Resource

The Calgary Heritage Authority (CHA), in accordance with its role to advise Council and Administration on heritage matters in the City of Calgary, would like to take this opportunity to support the designation of Cliff Bungalow School located in Cliff Bungalow as a Municipal Historic Resource.

Cliff Bungalow School is listed on the *CHA Inventory of Evaluated Historic Resources* as a City Wide Historic Resource.

Cliff Bungalow School has been an educational and social focal point of the community, serving in an educational capacity from 1920 to 1988 and subsequently as a community meeting place and the home of the community association. Known until 1927 as the 22nd Avenue Bungalow School, before taking the present name of "Cliff Bungalow School", the building functioned for 68 years as the community's elementary school.
