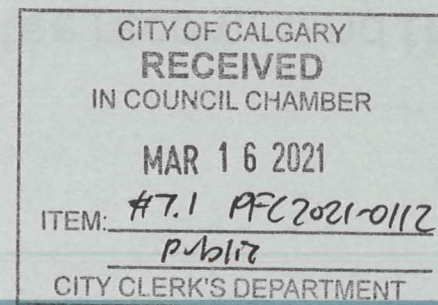

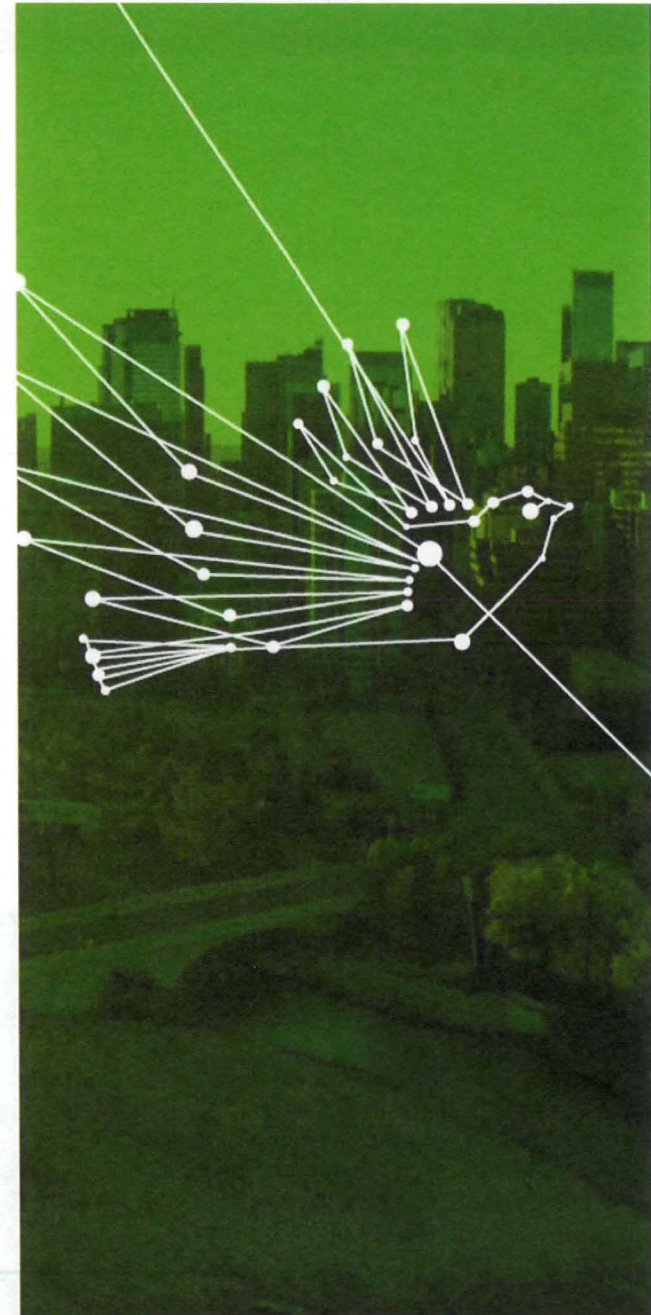

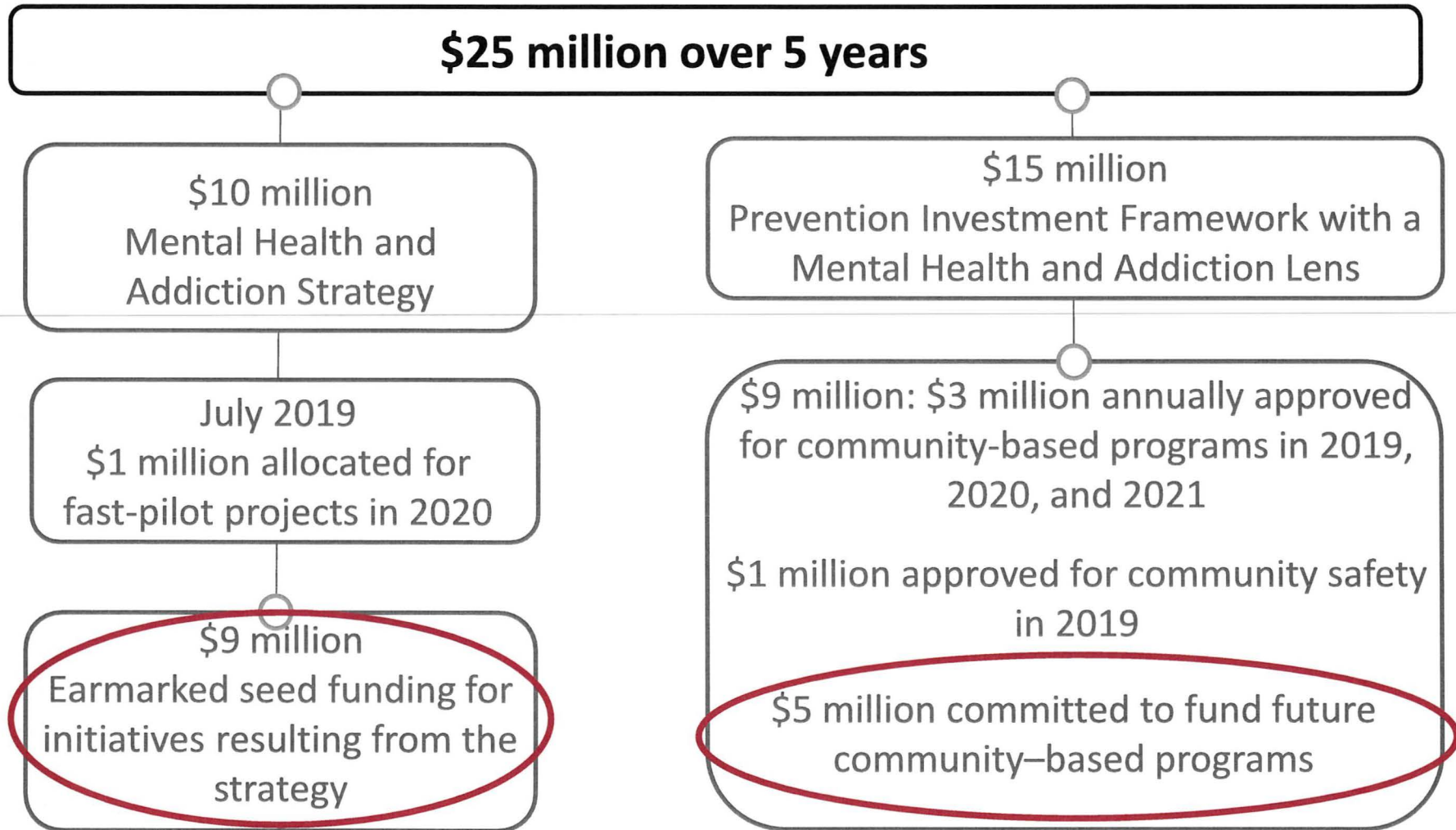
Community Investment Table and *Change Can't Wait!*

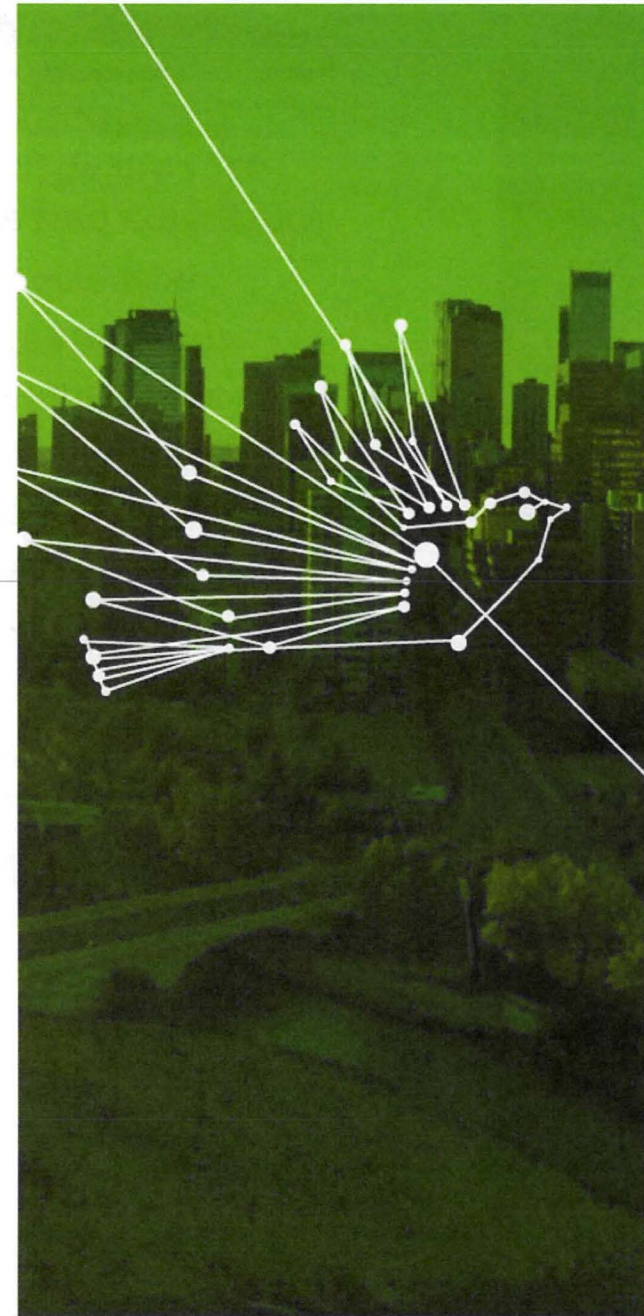
- Increased personal safety
