#### TRIP GENERATION

AM Peak: 19 additional vehicle trips

PM Peak: 28 additional vehicle trips


Well below 100 trips/hour threshold for Transportation Impact Assessment (TIA) studies

Not expected to appreciably alter area network traffic conditions

#### ON-STREET PARKING DEMAND

367 on-street parking stalls within a 1-block radius of the site No time-limit restrictions currently provided near the site

The maximum parking demand observed near the site was 190 out of the 367 stall supply (52%)



#### ACTIVE MODES

Walking: Walk Score of 82/100 (Very Walkable) as compared to the Calgary average Walk Score of 48/100 (Car Dependent),

#### Within a 20-minute walk:

- · Main Streets: 33 Ave SW / 34 Ave SW / 14 St SW
- · Schools: Richmond K-6, Mount Royal Junior High
- · Parks: South Calgary Park & Outdoor Pool
- Community Resources: cSpace King Edward, Marda Loop Communities Association, and the Giuffre Family Library

Cycling: Two nearby cycling routes (26 Avenue SW and 20 Street SW)

Transit: Short walk (400m) from the Route #6 (Centre City  $^-$  Killarney) bus stop, operating on a 15-min peak-hour frequency and 25-min off-peak hour frequency.


### TRANSPORTATION DEMAND MANAGEMENT (TDM) MEASURES

- . 3 on-site car-share vehicle for residents
- 17 on-site ebike-share bikes for residents
- On-site high-quality, secure indoor Class 1 bicycle parking and bicycle maintenance facility
- Marketing campaign for a reduced vehicle lifestyle to encourage use of on-site ebike and car-share options and active modes (walking, cycling and transit).
