Citywide Growth Strategy Industrial Encourage Intensification on Established Industrial Sites

Recommendation:

- The City should consider reduced or waived development-related fees, expedited planning approvals, or other initiatives to spur intensification within established industrial areas.
- This would lessen the need for new greenfield development, take advantage of existing servicing, provide employment in proximity to labour, and contribute to sustainable growth management.

Social Impact:

- Historic East Village ARP: A triple bottom line cost-benefit analysis of the environmental, social and economic impacts of inundation and mitigation should be considered to inform the optimal protection level and design of any flood mitigation measures.
- January's Combined Meeting of Council: it was suggested that council involve citizens to create understanding about social impact of proposed mining in the foothills.
