

Previous Council Direction and Timeline

January 27, 2020

Council Innovation Fund Application, City of Calgary Citizen Privacy Data Practices, PFC2020-0110

Council approved the following recommendations:

- a. application for Council Innovation Fund in the amount of \$75,000; and
- direct Administration to report back on the outcomes as part of the Privacy Framework 2019-2021 Workplan no later than Q1 2021.

January 27, 2020

City of Calgary Citizen Privacy Data Practices, C2020-0039

The City Clerk's Office reported back to Council on 2020 January 27 by providing:

- a. analysis of The City's current privacy practices;
- b. Privacy Framework 2019-2021 Workplan;
- c. information on current City Bylaws, Policies, and Procedures;
- d. information on current City Access to Information and Privacy training;
- e. examples of Smart City initiatives;
- f. a privacy vision and principles for The City that reinforce and build upon the purposes set out in the FOIP Act;
- g. results from open source research regarding a comparison of various Chief Privacy Officer roles and responsibility models; and
- information on privacy risks and the privacy practices that The City uses to mitigate those privacy risks.

Council approved the following recommendations:

- a. the Privacy Framework 2019-2021 Workplan (Attachment 1); and
- b. direct the City Clerk to provide an annual report to the Priorities and Finance Committee on The City's Privacy Management Program.

Notice of Motion - City of Calgary Citizen Privacy Data Practices, C2019-0590 Council adopted Notice of Motion (C2019-0590), City of Calgary Citizen Privacy Data Practices, directing the Chief Security Officer/Chief Information Security Officer, the Chief Information Technology Officer, Chief Human Resources Officer and the City Clerk in consultation with appropriate City staff and leading external privacy experts to:

- a. provide an analysis of The City's current privacy practices;
- develop a visible, accessible and overarching strategic Privacy Framework associated with digital infrastructure ('Smart Cities') and a Workplan for implementation;
- c. consider the Council Innovation Fund (CIF) which encourages innovation that
 has the potential to support or contribute to the goals of Council with city-wide
 application that have the potential to change city-wide policies, practices and
 procedures; and
- d. consider conducting a city-wide public consultation process on the Privacy Framework and data governance principles" (Notice of Motion – City of Calgary Citizen Data Privacy Practices, C2019-0560).
