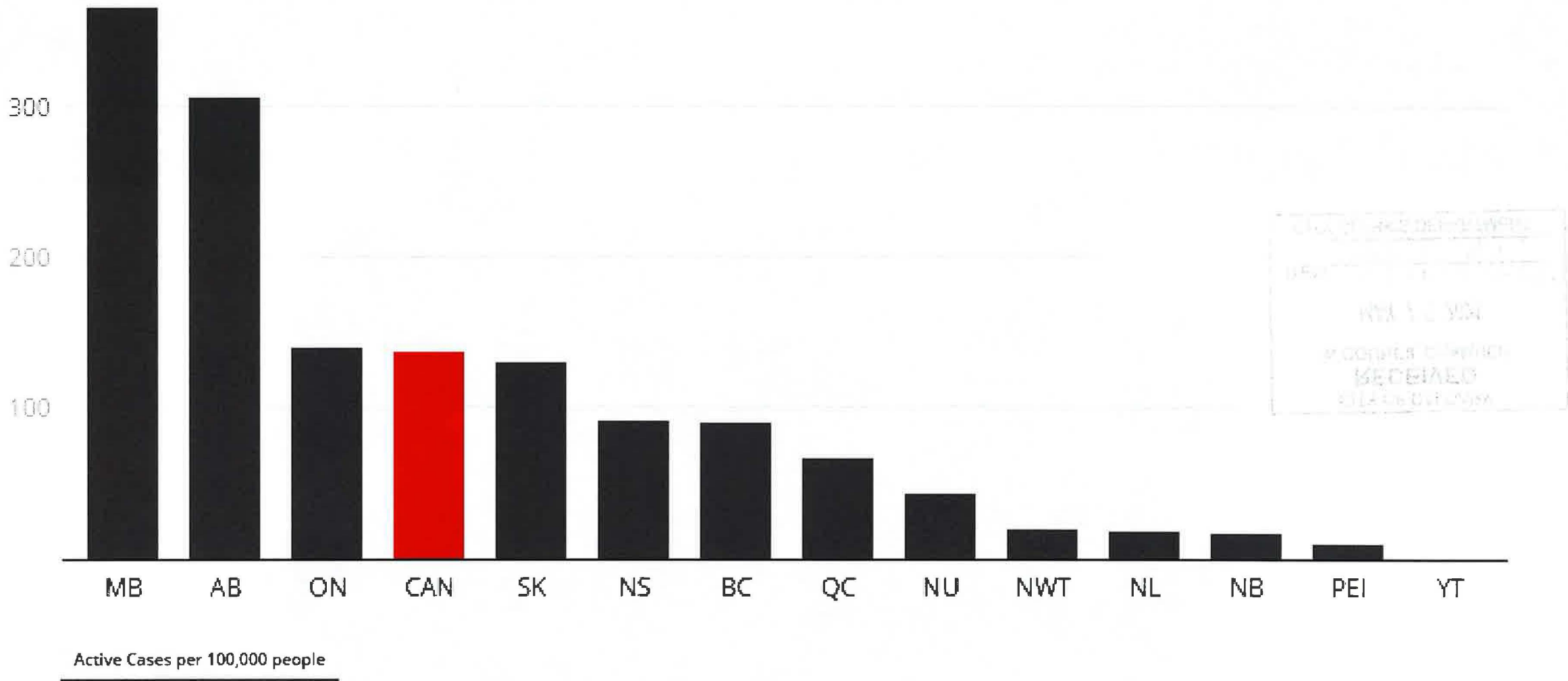

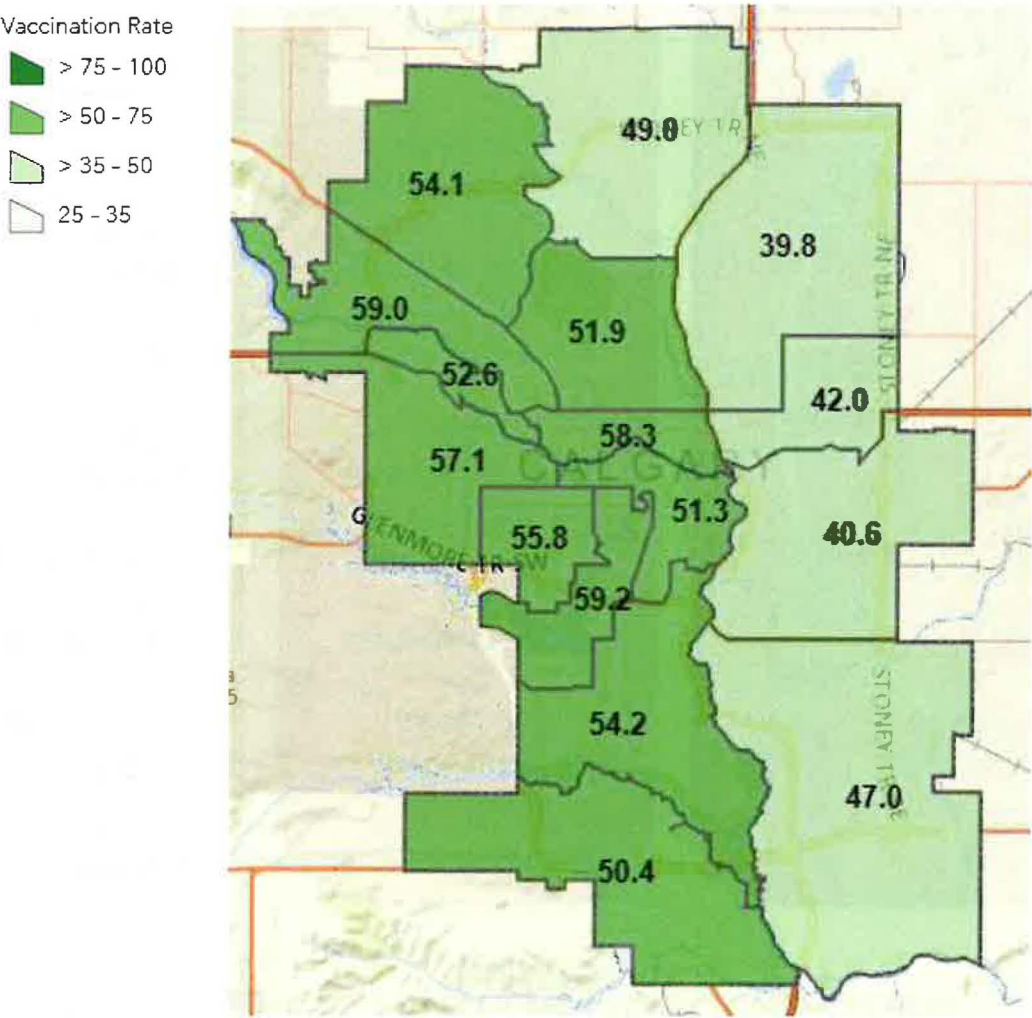

# Increasing Vaccinations

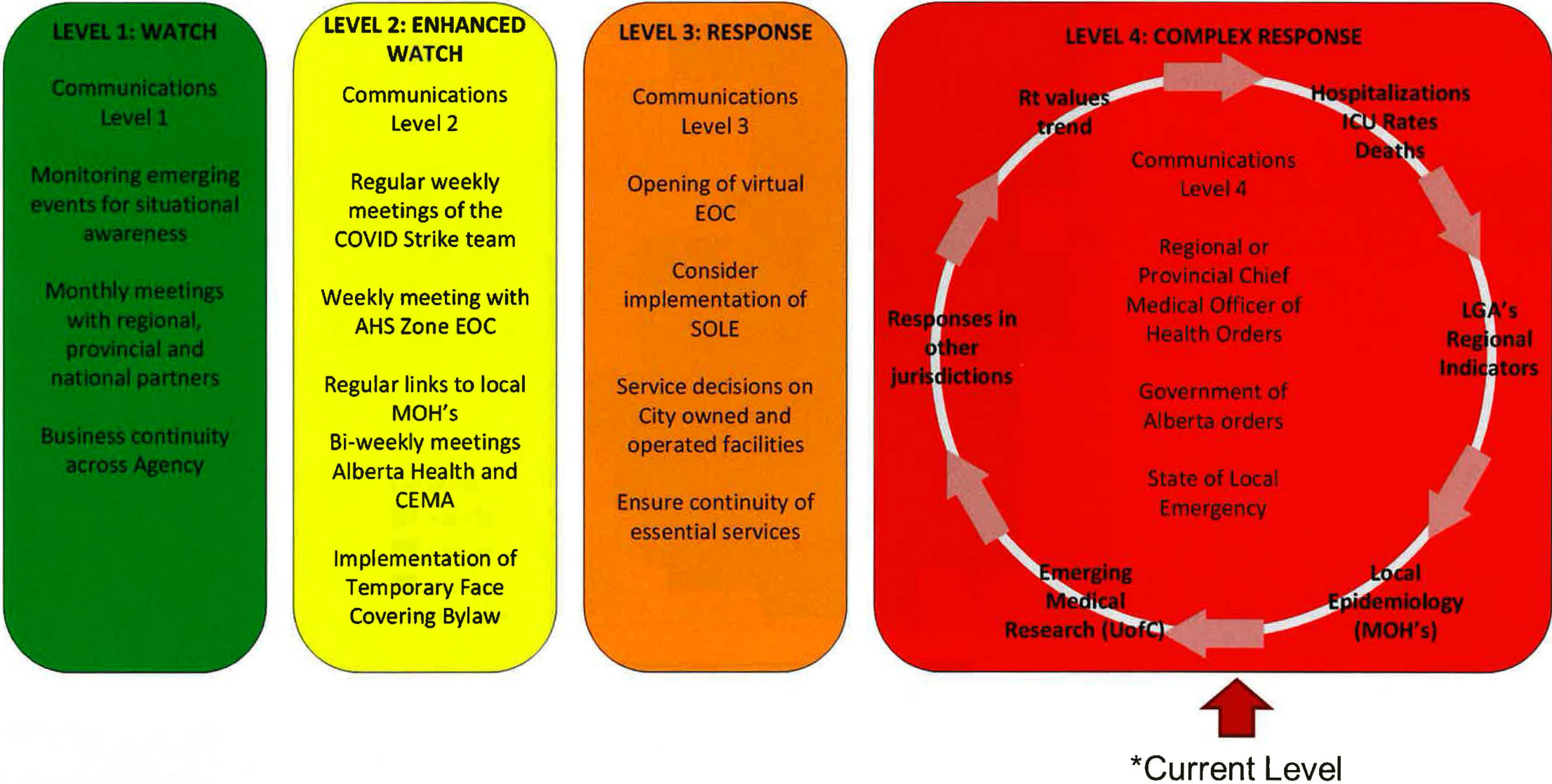
% Population with One Dose
