2020 Performance Measures




- 1. Facilities Maintenance large scale projects that would have required closure



Current State: Impact of COVID-19



- 1. Closures: March June, December to current
- 2. Part-time staff layoffs
- 3. School/education programs canceled
- 4. Facility rentals canceled
- 5. Visitation decrease 33,000 (2019) to 5,300 (2020)
- 6. Gift shop sales decrease
- 7. Special events canceled
- 8. Minimizing expenses marketing, collections, exhibits, other projects
