








Bylaw Review Process

All pillars of the review process informed recommended bylaw amendments





The proposed updated bylaw:







Is aligned with citizen expectations

Will increase public safety & liveability related to pet ownership

Will improve enforceability



Summary of Major Proposed Changes

Issue

 Animals in shelter for months

 Addressing nuisance behaviours when other measures unsuccessful.

Proposed Solution

 Expand Chief Bylaw Officer authority

 Expand designation to mitigate concerns

Intent

 Dogs returned home with safety parameters

 Improved ability to effectively address complex concerns



Summary of Major Proposed Changes



- Allow urban hens under a program that ensures proper care of hens and mitigates nuisance concerns
- Training will be required for urban hen owners

Summary of Major Proposed Changes

Issue

 Smell and Noise Complaints

 Control of large numbers of dogs in off leash areas.

Proposed Solution

- Limit on pet numbers
- Excess animals when appropriate
- Limit to 6 dogs off leash per person
- No limits for on leash dogs


Intent

 Decreased smell and noise concerns

 Able to monitor behaviour and pick up waste



Enforcement Philosophy





What Isn't Changing



- Barking and noise expectations
- Enforcing threatening behaviours
- Requiring vicious animals to be spayed/neutered
- Disallowing wheeled conveyance with a leashed dog on pathways



Administration's Recommendation

ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDATION

That the Standing Policy Committee on Community and Protective Services recommend that Council give three readings to the proposed Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw (Attachment 1) to replace Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw 23M2006.

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
