 - E. Athletic Development & Heritage (5 calls)



Recommendations:

The Priorities and Finance Committee recommend that Council direct Administration to:

- 1. Identify the advancement of Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) Calls to Action as a priority for the City of Calgary and a responsibility of all leaders and staff:
- 2. Establish an annual report to Calgarians on the progress made on TRC Calls to Action where The City has either a direct (Own) or indirect (Partner or Encourage) role, as outlined in the White Goose Flying Report; and,
- Bring forward a request for a budget increase for the Indigenous Relations Office through the November 2021 budget deliberations that will accelerate the advancement of actions outlined in the White Goose Flying Report.
