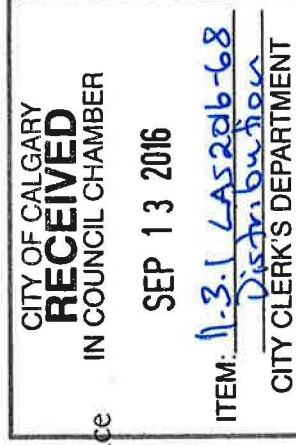

To All Members of Calgary City Council,

I write representing the 582 neighbours in the Rosedale Community who signed the attached petition. We ask you, our representatives, to reject using 8 remnant lots just south of 16th Avenue N.W. in our community for development. We who signed the petition have four substantive concerns - chiefly, the disproportionate cost, and the lack of consultation with all community members.

Our group has spent the summer talking with our neighbours who struggle to understand how bylaw 43Z2007, with it's clear purpose for these lots (as single-detached housing with sound attenuation) has changed and are now being proposed as one-bedroom duplexes.

The attached petition represents the 330 households we were able to reach over the summer where only 15 declined to sign. Some are city employees, and a few had other reasons. When considered as a percentage we have roughly 96% of community members in favour of meaningful consultation and opposed to the development based on cost. In talking with our neighbours, we heard clear support for affordable housing.

We ask that you accept this petition in the positive and constructive spirit it is intended in the hopes we can move to a consultation process with all residents of the Rosedale Community and together find a fiscally responsible effective solution.

PETITION

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- The greatest demand for affordable housing in Calgary is by families with children, and seniors. None of the 16 units will be made available for families with children, and none of them are being designed to accommodate the needs of seniors.
- When the lots were re-zoned from R-1 to DC in 2007, the public was notified that the re-zoning would permit single-family residences with sound attenuation on the remnant lots. Allowing the proposed development to proceed effectively implements a radical change to the Rosedale community without consultation. Homeowners must be contacted directly.

The undersigned object to any further action by the City of Calgary, the Affordable Housing Group within Calgary Housing Company or any other delegates of the City in relation to the construction of 16 units on the remnant lots in the 1600 block of 4A, 6th, 6A, 7A, 8th and 9th streets in Rosedale until meaningful public consultation occurs. The basis for my objection is that:

- There has been no meaningful consultation with the residents of Rosedale. A handful of homeowners in the 1600 block of the affected streets were advised of the change, but this is an issue that affects the entire community and the entire community's concerns need to be addressed with complete information provided.
- The proposed expenditure of \$4 million for 16 one-bedroom units is an inefficient use of taxpayer dollars. This estimate **does not** include the value of the land.
- The greatest demand for affordable housing in Calgary is by families with children, and seniors. None of the 16 units will be made available for families with children, and none of them are being designed to accommodate the needs of seniors.
- When the lots were re-zoned from R-1 to DC in 2007, the public was notified that the re-zoning would permit single-family residences with sound attenuation on the remnant lots. Allowing the proposed development to proceed effectively implements a radical change to the Rosedale community without consultation. Homeowners must be contacted directly.

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








