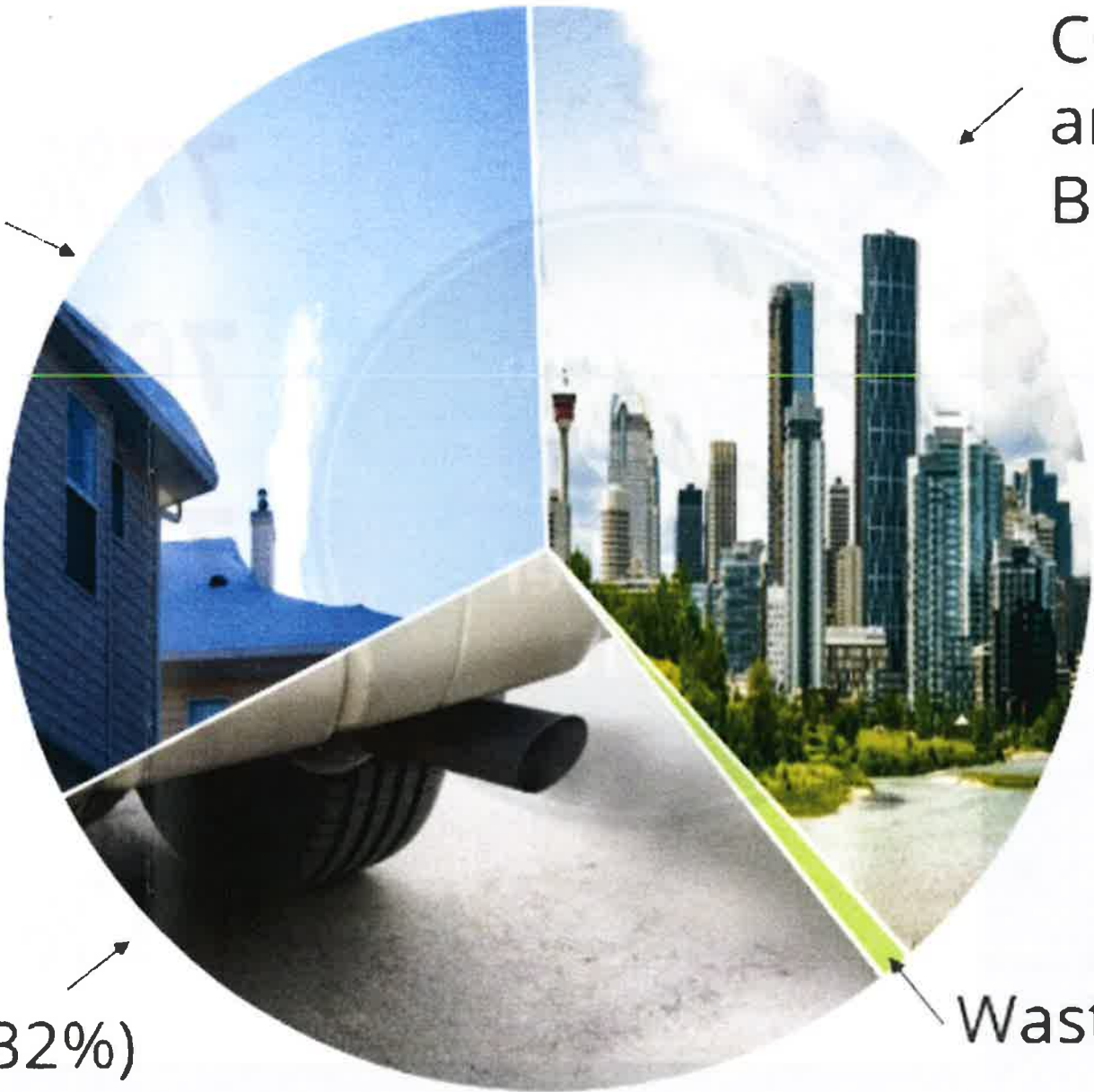
Calgary's Greenhouse Gas Emissions by Sector (2019)
