# **Crowchild Trail at Kensington Road NW**



Description:

Northbound Crowchild Trail to Westbound Kensington Road - left turn restriction during AM Peak period.

AND

Pedestrian only crossing of Parkdale Boulevard at Kensington Road.

Recommendation:

Implement turn restriction.

Benefits:

Anticipated ~60% improvement in delay for Northbound Traffic during AM and PM Peak period.

Timing and Funding:

Work can be completed as part of Roads Optimisation program, implementation anticipated in Q4 2016.

### Parkdale Boulevard at Kensington Road NW



Description:

Pedestrian only crossing of Parkdale Boulevard at Kensington Road.

Recommendation:

Install Pedestrian only crossing of Parkdale Boulevard at Kensington Road.

Benefits:

Improved connectivity for pedestrians and cyclists to get to the Bow River Pathway.

Timing and Funding:

Work can be included for Traffic Signal construction in 2017, completion by Q4 2017.

### **Crowchild Trail at 24 Avenue NW**



Description: Northbound left turn restriction

Recommendation:

Permanent installation of northbound left turn restriction, using lane control signage and gate arms.

### Benefits:

~ 90% delay improvement for NBT in PM peak and ~62% delay improvement in AM peak.

Timing and Funding:

Work can be included for Traffic Signal construction in 2017, completion by Q4 2017.

### Crowchild Trail between 23 Avenue and 24 Avenue NW



Description:

Revise un-signalized left turns on Crowchild Trail

Recommendation:

Revise un-signalized left turns on Crowchild Trail to right in/right out access only.


Benefits:

Provides safety performance improvements for Crowchild Trail.

Timing and Funding:

Work can be included for construction in 2017, completion by Q4 2017.

#### **Crowchild Trail at 16 Avenue NW**



Description: Ramp from Westbound 16 Avenue to Northbound Crowchild Trail

Recommendation:

Construct new ramp to connect westbound 16 Avenue to Northbound Crowchild Trail

Benefits:

Provides a direct connection between 16 Avenue and Crowchild Trail, anticpated reduction in traffic on Banff Trail and 24 Avenue NW.

Timing and Funding:

Identified as part of Foothills Hospital/Stadium/Banff Trail Station Transit Oriented Development, a funded project in Investing in Mobility, 2015-2020 timeframe, funding to be confirmed.
