#### Council Direction


Return to Council no later than 2021 July 05 with the intention of repealing the Bylaw as soon as possible, provided that the local situation is deemed safe based on an evaluation of trends and rates related to the following criteria:

- Local second doses are high on a comparative scale
- Infection rates are stable or declining
- Hospitalization and Intensive Care Unit rates are stable and/or declining
- Positivity rates are stable and/or declining


# Percentage of Population Fully Vaccinated




Percentage of eligible Albertans with Second Dose:



### **Infection Rates**




# Regional Indicator (Cases/100k Population)






### Hospitalization and ICU Rates
