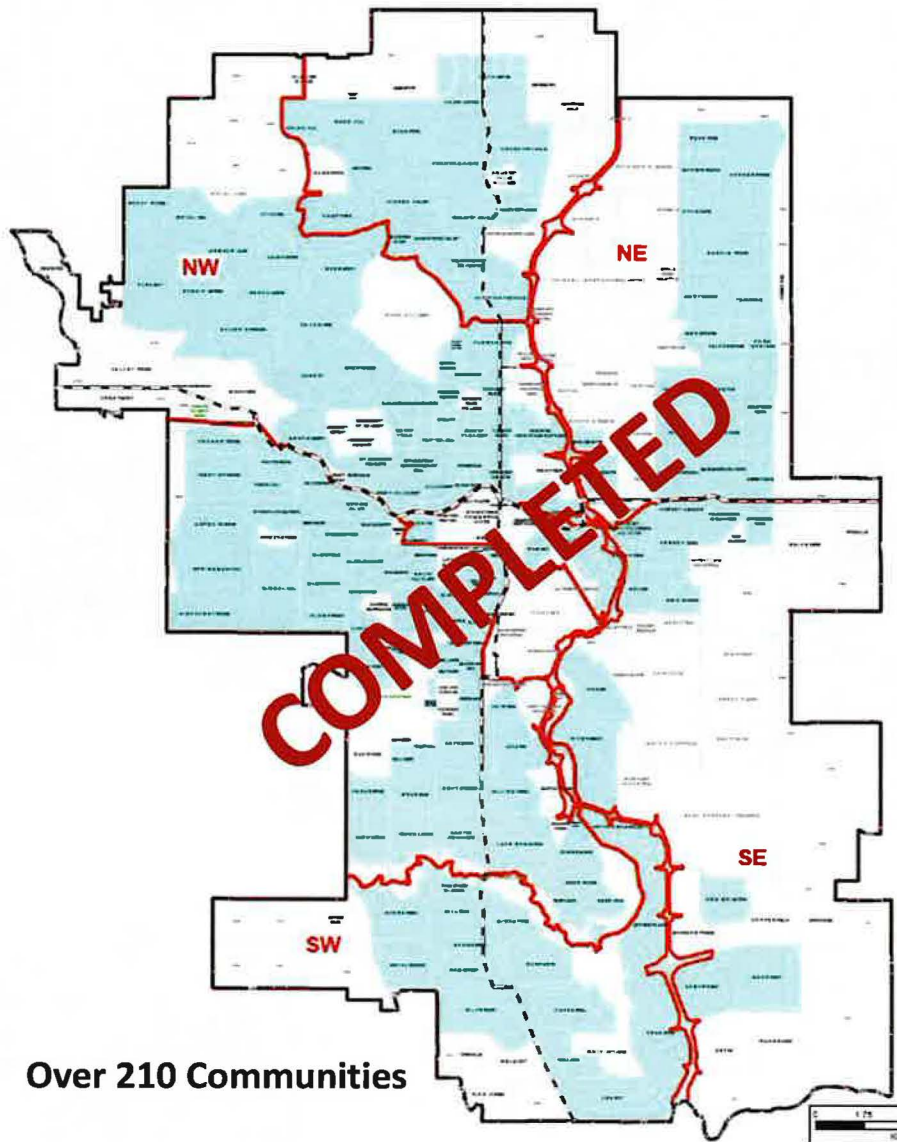

- Mowing along high traffic roadways / boulevards
- Loaming and seeding of areas damaged throughout winter months
- Removing noxious weeds on boulevards
- Supporting naturalization efforts

Gravel Lane Repair Program

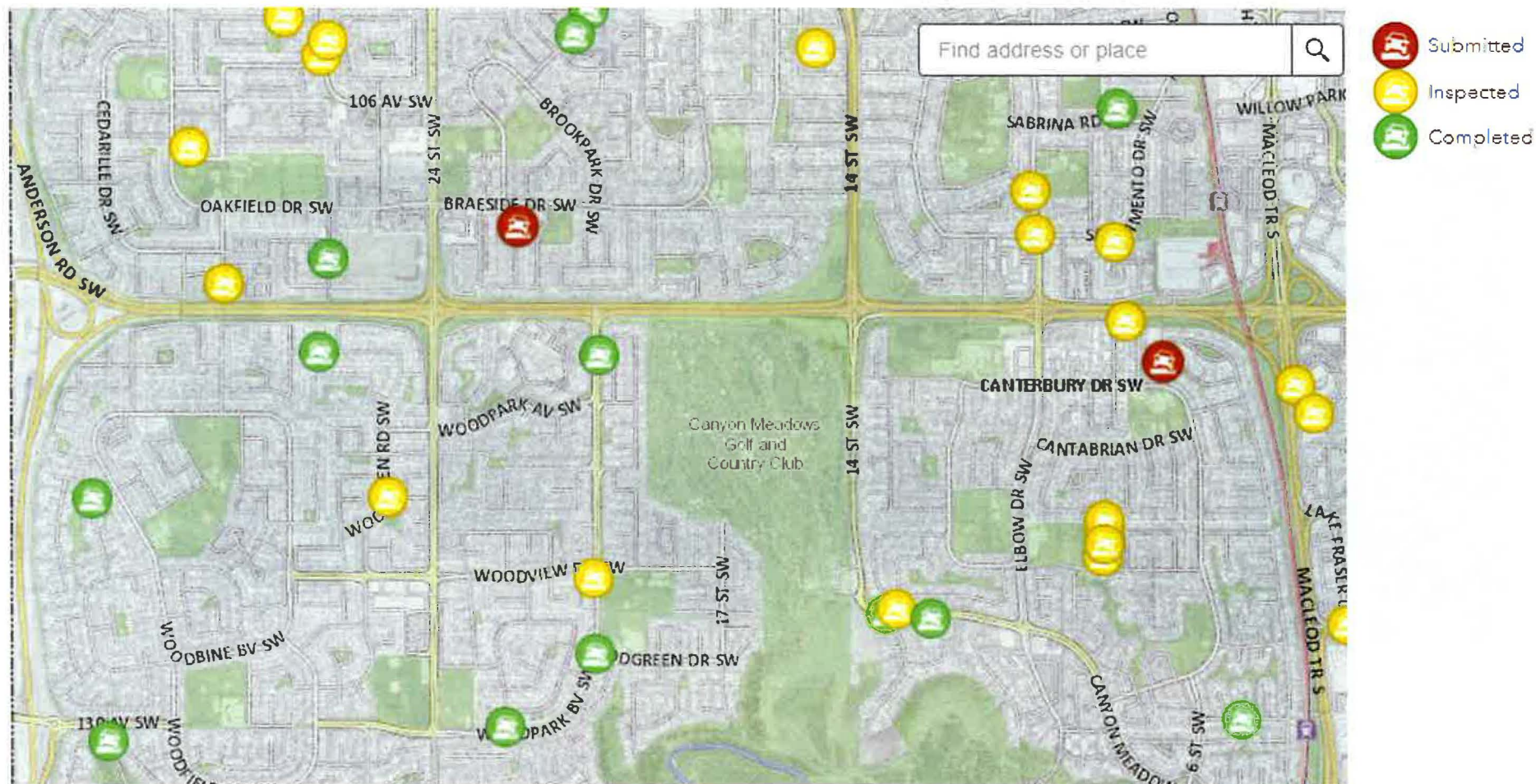


- Gravel lane repairs to improve drainage / surface condition (over 2000 lane km)
- Application of calcium chloride to control dust as necessary
- Storm clean-up due to wash outs

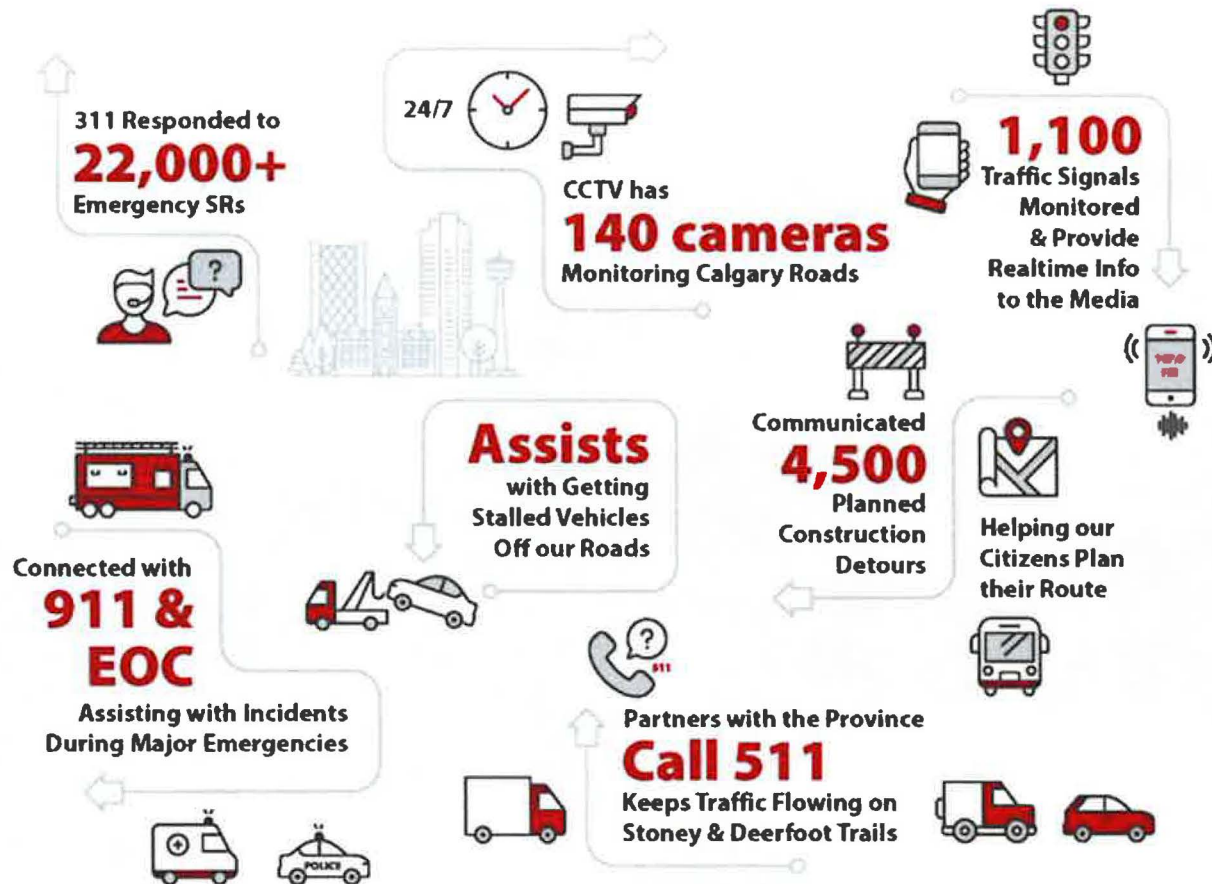
