



DC DIRECT CONTROL DISTRICT

Purpose

- 1 This Direct Control District is intended to:
 - (a) accommodate a **Beverage Container Drop-Off Depot** as a *use*; and
 - (b) provide **use** specific rules such as size and location for **Beverage** Container Drop-Off Depot.

Compliance with Bylaw 1P2007

2 Unless otherwise specified, the rules and provisions of Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Bylaw 1P2007 apply to this Direct Control District.

Reference to Bylaw 1P2007

Within this Direct Control District, a reference to a section of Bylaw 1P2007 is deemed to be a reference to the section as amended from time to time.

Permitted Uses

The *permitted uses* of the Industrial Edge (I-E) District of Bylaw 1R2007 are the *permitted uses* in this Direct Control District.

Discretionary Uses

- The **discretionary uses** of the Industrial Edge (I-E) District of Bylaw 1P2007 are the **discretionary uses** in this Direct Control District with the addition of:
 - (a) Beverage Container Drop-Off Depot.

Bylaw 1P2007 District Rules

Unless otherwise specified, the rules of the Industrial Edge (I-E) District of Bylaw 1P2007 apply in this Direct Control District.

Rules for Beverage Container Drop-Off Depot

- 7 (1) The maximum cumulative *gross floor area* for a **Beverage Container Drop-Off Depot** is 85 per cent of a **building** in which it is located.
 - (2) The minimum number of **motor vehicle parking stalls** for a **Beverage** Container Drop-Off Depot is 20.
 - (3) A Beverage Container Drop-Off Depot must not have outdoor storage.

Location of Uses

With the exception of **Beverage Container Drop-Off Depot**, all **uses** must front onto Bowridge Drive NW.
